Royal Princess Doll Outfit

Knit a fairy tale ensemble for a special 18" (45.7 cm) doll to wear on her next fantasy adventure. We've included dress, flowered shoes, fur-trimmed cape and the perfect crown.

What you will need (continued):

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] and 5.5mm [US 9] straight needles, and 4mm [US 6] and 5.5mm [US 9] set of double pointed needles.

Three 5/8" [16mm] buttons, 30" [76 cm] length of 3/4" [19 mm] wide ribbon, 4 stitch markers, sewing needle and thread, yarn needle.

Outfit is designed to fit an 18" [45.5 cm] doll.

Finished Measurements Dress

Finished Neck 9" [23 cm]

Finished Chest 12" [30.5 cm]

Finished Length 10" [25.5 cm] from neck to lower edge

Cape

Finished Neck 6" (15 cm)

Finished Length 10" [25.5 cm] from neck to lower edge

Crown

Finished Circumference 10" [25.5 cm]

Finished Height 2 1/4" [5.5 cm]

Notes

1. Outfit includes a dress, cape, slippers, and crown.
2. Dress is knit from the neck downwards. Bodice is worked back and forth in rows then piece is joined to work skirt in rounds.
3. Cape is knit from the neck downwards, back and forth in rows.
4. Sole of each slipper is worked back and forth in rows then sides are worked in rounds. Slipper is completed by working top of slipper in short rows.
5. Crown is worked back and forth in rows.

Special Stitches

kfb (knit into front and back) = Knit next stitch but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same stitch and remove from needle - 1 st increased.

kfbf (Knit into front, back, then front of same st) = Knit into front of next stitch without removing stitch from needle, then knit into back of same stitch and then into front again, remove stitch from needle - 2 sts increased.

M1 (make 1 - increase) = Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole - 1 st increased.

MB (make bobble) = Knit into front of next stitch without removing stitch from needle, [knit into back of same stitch, knit into front of same stitch] twice, knit into back of same stitch, slip 6 stitches just made back to left hand needle, knit all 6 stitches together through back loops.

skp (slip, knit, pass slipped stitch over) = Slip next stitch as if to knit to right needle, knit next stitch, lift slipped stitch over knit stitch and off needle - 1 st decreased.

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What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 381 Light Blue **A**, 316 Soft White **B**, and 722 Pretty 'n Pink **C**

RED HEART® Fur™: 1 ball 9100 Polar **D**

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" [10 cm];
24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) using smaller straight needles. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

DRESS

Bodice

Beginning at neck edge with smaller straight needles and **A**, cast on 38 sts.

Row 1 (wrong side): [P1, k1] twice, [p5, place marker] twice, p11, pm, p5, pm, p4, [k1, p1] twice.

Row 2 (increase row): [K1, p1] twice, [knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, kfb] 4 times, knit to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice—46 sts.

Row 3 (buttonhole row): P1, k1, yarn over, k2tog, purl to last 4 sts slipping markers as you come to them, [k1, p1] twice.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2—54 sts.

Row 5: [P1, k1] twice, purl to last 4 sts slipping markers as you come to them, [k1, p1] twice.

Row 6: [K1, p1] twice, [knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, kfb] 4 times, knit to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice—62 sts.

Rows 7 and 8: Repeat Rows 5 and 6—70 sts.

Row 9 (buttonhole row): Repeat Row 3.

Row 10: Repeat Row 6—78 sts.

Rows 11–14: Repeat Rows 5 and 6 twice and remove the markers as you work Row 14—94 sts.

Shape Armholes

Row 15 (buttonhole row): P1, k1, yarn over, k2tog, p12, bind off 19 sts for first armhole, purl to last 35 sts, bind off 19 sts for second armhole, purl to last 4 sts, [k1, p1] twice—56 sts.

Row 16: [K1, p1] twice, knit to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice.

Row 17: [P1, k1] twice, purl to last 4 sts, [k1, p1] twice.

Rows 18 and 19: Repeat Rows 16 and 17.



Skirt

Change to larger double pointed needles.

Join to begin working in rounds (right side): With first double pointed needle, [k1, p1] twice; with next double pointed needle, k17; with next double pointed needle, k18; with next double pointed needle, k13; with right side facing, hold

needles in a circle and hold 4 sts on first double pointed needle behind 4 sts remaining on straight needle; continuing with last double pointed needle used, [knit next st on straight needle and next st on first double pointed needle together] 4 times—52 sts (17 sts on each of 2 double pointed needles and 18 sts on 1 double pointed needle). Place a marker for beginning of round and prepare to work in rounds.

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: Kfb in each st around—104 sts.

Round 3: K6, [kfb, k9] 9 times, kfb, k7—114 sts.

Round 4: Knit.

Repeat Round 4 until skirt measures about 5¾" [14.5 cm].

Work in Garter stitch worked in rounds (purl 1 round, knit 1 round) for 6 rounds. Bind off as if to knit.



CAPE

Beginning at neck edge with larger straight needles and **D**, cast on 22 sts.

Rows 1 and 2: Knit.

Cut **D**. Change to **B** and work remainder of cape with **B** only.

Row 3 (wrong side): Kfbf in each st across—66 sts.

Row 4: Slip first st as if to knit, p1, k1, p1, knit to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice.

Row 5: Slip first st as if to purl, k1, p1, k1, purl to last 4 sts, [k1, p1] twice.

Row 6 (increase row): Slip first st as if to knit, p1, k1, p1, k2, [k5, kfb] 8 times, k8, [p1, k1] twice—74 sts.

Row 7: Repeat Row 5.

Rows 8 and 9: Repeat Rows 4 and 5.

Row 10 (increase row): Slip first st as if to knit, p1, k1, p1, k2, [k6, kfb] 8 times, k8, [p1, k1] twice—82 sts.

Row 11: Repeat Row 5.

Rows 12 and 13: Repeat Rows 4 and 5.

Row 14 (increase row): Slip first st as if to knit, p1, k1, p1, k2, [k7, kfb] 8 times, k8, [p1, k1] twice—90 sts.

Row 15: Repeat Row 5.

Rows 16 and 17: Repeat Rows 4 and 5.

Row 18 (increase row): Slip first st as if to knit, p1, k1, p1, k2, [k8, kfb] 8 times, k8, [p1, k1] twice—98 sts.

Row 19: Repeat Row 5.

Repeat Rows 4 and 5 until piece measures about 9½" [24 cm] from beginning.

Work in Garter stitch (knit every row) for 3 rows.

Bind off as if to knit.

Finishing Cape: Thread ribbon into yarn needle and weave ribbon through 3rd row of cape. Weave in ends.

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SLIPPERS (make 2) Sole

Beginning at heel end of sole with smaller double pointed needles and **A**, cast on 4 sts. Work back and forth in rows using 2 double pointed needles.

Row 1 (right side): Knit to last st, kfb—5 sts.

Row 2: Purl to last st, kfb—6 sts.

Work in Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) for 12 rows.

Sides

Round 1 (right side): K6; with next double pointed needle, pick up and k9 sts along side of sole; with next double pointed needle, pick up and k4 sts along cast on edge; with next double pointed needle pick up and k9 sts along next side of sole—28 sts. Place marker for beginning of round and prepare to work in rounds.

Rounds 2-4: Knit.

Remove beginning of round marker.

Top

Note: Top of slipper is worked back and forth in short rows. Short rows are worked over only a portion of all stitches. Turn work when instructed.

Row 1 (right side): K1, k2tog, skp, k1, sl 1 as if to knit, turn.

Row 2 (wrong side): P1, p2tog through back loops, p2tog, p1, sl 1 as if to purl, turn.

Row 3: K1, k2tog, skp, k1, sl 1 as if to knit, turn.

Row 4: P1, p2tog through back loops, p2tog, p1, do NOT turn.

Note: A total of 20 sts remain on needles.

Round 5 (wrong side): P20.

With wrong side still facing, bind off as if to purl.

Finishing Slipper: Weave in ends.

Flowers (make 2 - 1 for each slipper)

With smallest double pointed needles and **B**, cast on 20 sts. Work back and forth in rows using 2 double pointed needles.

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

Row 2: [P4tog] 5 times—5 sts.

Bind off as if to knit, leaving a long tail.

Gently arrange piece into a flower shape.

With tail, sew a few stitches through bottom of flower to maintain shape.

Sew one flower to the toe of each slipper.

CROWN

Strap

With smaller straight needles and **C**, cast on 3 sts.

Work in Garter stitch for 18 rows.

Shape Crown

Row 1 (wrong side): K1, M1, knit to end of row—4 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3 (bobble row): MB, knit to end of row.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K1, M1, knit to end of row—5 sts.

Rows 6-9: Repeat Rows 4 and 5 twice—7 sts.

Rows 10-17: Repeat Rows 2-9—10 sts.

Row 18: Knit.

Row 19 (bobble row): MB, knit to end of row.

Row 20: Knit.

Row 21: K1, k2tog, knit to end of row—9 sts.

Rows 22-25: Repeat Rows 20 and 21 twice—7 sts.

Rows 26-33: Repeat Rows 18-25—4 sts.

Rows 34-37: Repeat Rows 18-21—3 sts.

Strap

Work in Garter stitch for 18 rows.

Finishing Crown: Bind off as if to knit, leaving a long tail. Use tail to sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, and C = Color A, Color B, and Color C; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **p2tog** = purl next 2 sts together; **p4tog** = purl next 4 sts together; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
