

## Floral Knit Doll Accessories

Complete your doll's look with the perfect knit accessories. Triangle Shawl, Beret and Tote bag are all embellished with little knit posies that any girl would love to have in their 18" doll's wardrobe.

RED HEART ${ }^{\ominus}$ "Soft Yarn": 1 ball each 9528 Lilac A, 9770 Rose Blush B and 2541 Blue Sky C.

Knitting Needles: 4.5mm [US 7].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4"; 28 rows = 4" in Ridge pat. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

M1 (make one stitch) = Lift running thread before next stitch onto left needle and knit into the back loop.

## TRIANGLE SHAWL

With $\mathbf{A}$, cast on 1 st.
Next Row: K1, p1, k1 all in the same st-3 sts.

## Begin Ridge Pattern

Rows 1 and 3: K1, yo, knit to end.
Rows 2 and 4: K1, yo, purl to last st, k1.
Row 5: K1, yo, knit to last st, yo, k1.
Row 6 (Ridge): Repeat Row 5.
Repeat Rows 3-6 until shawl measures $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, end by working Row 5 of pattern. Bind off knitwise.

## FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.

## BERET

With B, cast on 49 sts.

## Brim Ribbing

Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from * to last st, k1.
Row 2: * P1, k1; repeat from * to last st, p1.
Repeat Rows 1 and 2 once more.

## Begin Ridge Pattern and shaping

Rows 1, 11, 15, 19 and 23: Knit.
Rows 2, 6, 10, 14, 18, 22, 26 and 30: Purl.
Row 3: [K4, m1] 11 times, k5-60 sts.
Rows 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24 and 28 (Ridge): Knit.
Row 5: [K5, m1, k4, m1] 6 times, k6-72 sts.
Row 7: [K6, m1, k5, m1] 6 times, k6-84 sts.
Row 9: [K7, m1, k6, m1] 6 times, k6-96 sts.
Row 13: [K6, k2tog, k5, k2tog] 6 times, k6-84 sts.
Row 17: [K5, k2tog, k4, k2tog] 6 times, k3, k2tog, k1-71 sts.
Row 21: [K4, k2tog, k3, k2tog] 6 times, k2, k2tog, k1-58 sts.
Row 25: [K3, k2tog, k2, k2tog] 6 times, k1, k2tog, k1-45 sts.
Row 27: [K2, k2tog, k1, k2tog] 6 times, k2tog, k1-32 sts.
Row 29: [K1, k2tog, k2tog] 6 times, k2tog-19 sts.
Row 31: K2tog across row to last st. k1-10 sts.
Cut yarn leaving a 12 " tail. Thread yarn through remaining sts to secure. Sew seam from top of beret to rib edge. Weave in all ends.

## TOTE

## Side (Make 2)

With A, cast on 22 sts.
Next Row: Knit 1 row even.

## Begin Ridge Pattern

Rows 1 and 3: Knit.
Row 2: Purl.
Row 4 (Ridge): Knit.
Repeat Rows 1-4, once more.

## Stripe Sequence

Repeat Stripe Sequence as follows:
With C work Rows 2-4 twice.
With B work Rows 2-4 twice.
With A work Rows 2-4 once, then work Rows 2-4 once more.
Next Row: Bind off knitwise.

## Strap

With C, cast on 5 sts.
Work in Garter st until piece measures 20 ". Bind off.


FINISHING
Sew cast on and bind off edges of strap together. Place strap seam at center bottom of first side piece and sew around bottom and sides. Repeat for second side. Weave in yarn ends.

## Rosettes

## Small (Medium)

With color of your choice, cast on 16 (32) sts.
Knit 3 (5) rows. Bind off. Cut yarn leaving tail.
Roll piece into a spiral and tack in place. Use a contrasting color to embroider optional loose loops at center of flower. Attach rosette(s) as desired.

RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ "Soft Yarn", Art. E728 available in solid color $5 \mathrm{oz}(140 \mathrm{~g})$, 256 yd ( 234 m ), print $4 \mathrm{oz}(113 \mathrm{~g}), 204 \mathrm{yd}$ (187 m), and heathers 4oz, (113g) 212 yd (194m) balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=\operatorname{stitch}(e s) ; \mathbf{t o g}=$ together; yo = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
