What you will need:

RED HEART® Lollit™: 2 balls of 9931 Popsicle (1 ball is for Hat, and 1 ball for Scarf)

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 10mm [US 15] (for Scarf), 9mm [US 13] (for Hat)

Stitch holder (for Hat), yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm); 10 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette st with smaller needles; 9 sts = 4" (10 cm) with larger needles. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Funky Fun Hat & Scarf

This cheerful set is fun for girls to wear! Knit this hat or scarf in any shade of this colorful chenille-type yarn with funky little loops to add some extra zing to the look!

Scarf measures about 5 x 56" (12.5 x 142 cm)
Hat measures about 18" (45.5 cm) circumference
Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

HAT

With smaller needles, cast on 44 sts.

Rows 1–8: *K1, p1; repeat from * across. Beginning with a right side (knit) row work in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) until piece measures about 6" (15 cm) from beginning, end with a wrong side (purl) row.

Shape Crown

Row 1: [K1, k2tog] 14 times, k2—30 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of row—15 sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: P6, p2tog, p7—14 sts.

Ties (for top knot)

K7, place remaining 7 sts on a holder. Work in Stockinette st over the 7 sts remaining on needle for about 5" (12.5 cm). Bind off. Return the 7 sts from holder to needle and work in Stockinette st for about 5" (12.5 cm). Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew side edges of piece together for back seam, leaving ties free. Weave in ends. Loosely knot ties twice on top of Hat.

SCARF

With larger needles, cast on 11 sts.

Rows 1–3: Knit.

Row 4: Purl.

Rows 5–9: Knit.

Row 10: Purl.

Repeat Rows 5–10 until piece measures about 56" (142 cm) from beginning, end with a purl row.

Next 2 Rows: Knit.

Bind off as if to knit.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **p2tog** = purl next 2 sts together; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
