## What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each of 9528 Lilac A and 9940 Plummy B.

Susan Bates® Double Pointed Needles: 5 mm [US 8].

Susan Bates® Straight Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8].

Stitch markers, stitch holder.

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4" (10 cm); 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette Stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

# Berry-licious Scarf & Wristers

Almost every little girl loves purple, and every little girl who loves purple will love these soft wristers and this purple-licious scarf. They'll keep her warm and cozy all winter long!

**SHOP KIT** 

Directions are for size 2; changes for size 4, 6. and 8 are in parentheses.

Scarf measures approximately 4" (10 cm) wide and 48" (122 cm) long.

Wristers measure 4¼ (4¾, 4¾, 5½)" [11 (12, 12, 13) cm] circumference.

#### Special Abbreviations

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand betweenneedles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting the stitch to prevent a hole in the fabric.

## **WRISTERS**

#### Cuff

With double pointed needles and A, cast on 17(19.19, 21) sts evenly across needles. Join. being careful that sts are not twisted, and begin working in the round. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 1 (Right side): Knit around. Round 2: Purl around.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until piece measures approximately 1" (3 cm) from cast on edge. Cut A. Attach B. knit around until piece measures 1¾ (2, 2¼, 2½)" [4 (5, 6, 6) cm] from cast on edge.

#### **Thumb Gusset**

**Round 1:** K8 (9,9,10), place marker, K1, place marker, K8 (9,9,10).

Round 2: Knit to marker, slip marker, M1, knit to next marker, M1, slip marker, knit around: 19 (21,21,23) sts.

Rounds 3 and 4: Knit around.

Repeat Rounds 2-4 until there are 7 (7,9,9) sts between markers, ending with Round 2: 23 (25,27,29) sts.

**Next Round:** Knit around to first marker, remove marker, place 7 (7.9,9) sts on holder, cast on 1 st, remove marker, knit around.

#### Hand

Knit around until piece measures approximately 3½ (4,4½,5)" [8 (10, 11, 13) cm] from cast on edae. Cut B.

Round 1: Attach A, knit around.

Round 2: Purl around.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until piece measures approximately 4¼ (4¾,5,5¾)" [11 (12,13, 13) cm] from cast on edge. Bind off all stitches in pattern.

#### Thumb

Divide 7 (7,9,9) sts from holder onto 3 dpns. Join B and pick up and knit 1 st over cast on st, knit around, cut **B**: 8 (8,10,10) sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 1 (Right side): Attach A, knit around.

Round 2: Purl around. Bind off all sts in knit.

### **SCARF**

With straight knitting needles and A, cast on 18 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Rows 2-6: Knit across, at the end of Row 6, cut A.

Row 7: With B, knit across.

Row 8: Purl across.

Row 9: Knit across.

Row 10: Purl across.

Rows 11-18: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 four times, at the end of Row 18 cut B.

Row 19: With A, knit across.

Rows 20-26: With A, knit across, at the end of Row 26 cut A.

Repeat Rows 7-26 for pattern until piece measures approximately 47" (119 cm) from cast on edge or to desired length.

Bind off all stitches in knit.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C, etc = Colors A, B, C, etc; K = knit; mm= millimeter; P = purl; st(s) = stitch(es).
