What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball 9440
Light Grey Heather

**Susan Bates® Circular Knitting
Needle:** 5.5mm [US 9] 16" [40
cm]; third needle in same size, any
type, for 3-needle bind-off

1.75 quart [1.7 liter] hot water
bottle, stitch markers, cable
needle, yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24
rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette
stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
**Use any size needles to obtain
the gauge.**

SHOP KIT

Hot Water Bottle Cover

This classic turtleneck style cover for a hot water bottle is the perfect get well gift for a friend who needs some tender loving care. The stretchy rib opening keeps the sweater in place but also allows for easy removal.

**Cover will fit 1.75 quart [1.7 liter] hot
water bottle.**

**Circumference at widest point: 17" [43
cm]**

Length of Body: 10" [25.5 cm]

Notes

Cover is worked in the round from the top
down. When working in the round, slip
markers when you come to them.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

k1fb = knit into front and back of next
stitch.

2/2 RC = Slip 2 to cable needle, hold to
back, k2; k2 from cable needle.

2/2 LC = Slip 2 to cable needle, hold to
front, k2; k2 from cable needle.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

3-Needle Bind-off (seaming 2 pieces
together as you bind off) Place stitches of
pieces to be joined on separate needles
or each end of a circular needle, hold one
behind the other with right sides facing
each other in left hand; with a third needle
the same size, k2tog (1 from one needle and
1 from the other) - 1 st on right-hand needle,
*k2tog in same manner, bind off; repeat from *.

PATTERN STITCHES

2 x 2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)

All Rounds: *K2, p2; repeat from * to end of
round.

HOT WATER BOTTLE COVER

Neck

Cast on 56 sts. Join, placing 1 marker at
beginning of round and second at halfway
point; begin to work circularly.
Work 2 x 2 Rib for 7" [18 cm].

Body

Increase Round: [K1fb, knit to 1 st before
marker, k1fb] twice – 60 sts.

Repeat Increase Round 3 times – 72 sts.

Rounds 1 and 3: [K12, p2, k8, p2, k12] twice.

Round 2: *K12, p2, [2/2 RC] twice, p2, k12;
repeat from * once.

Round 4: *K12, p2, k2, 2/2 LC, k2, p2, k12;
repeat from * once.

Repeat Rounds 1-4 until piece measures 9"
[23 cm] from start of Body, ending with a
Round 1.

Shape Bottom

Work 4 rounds of 2 x 2 Rib.

Decrease Round: [K2, p2tog] 18 times – 54
sts.

Next Round: [K2, p1] 18 times.

Next Round: [K1, k2tog] 18 times – 36 sts.

FINISHING

Remove markers. With third needle and
holding points of circular needle parallel,
work 3-needle bind-off to close bottom of
cover. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit
2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** =
purl; **p2tog** = purl 2 sts together; **St st** =
Stockinette stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** =
together; [] = work directions in brackets
the number of times specified; * or ** =
repeat whatever follows the * or ** as
indicated.



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
