# What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 1 skein each 1252 Mango A and 1704 Bubble Gum B.

**Double Pointed Knitting Needles:** 3.5mm [US 4].

Stitch marker, yarn needle, plastic pellets.

**GAUGE:** 24 sts = 4". 29 rows = 4" in charted wave pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

# Cell Phone Resting Place

This neat pillow is just what's needed for keeping your cell phone attractively displayed when not in use or charging. Knit it in two bright colors as shown, or in any colors that you please. This is a great gift idea!

Stand measures 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm)

#### NOTE

Carry color not in use loosely across wrong side of work. When changing colors, pick up new color to be used under color just used to prevent a hole.

## **PILLOW**

With A, cast on 48 sts. Divide stitches evenly over 4 needles, leaving a long tail for sewing. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Round 1 (Right Side): Knit.

Work rows 1 - 6 from chart. Repeat chart 6 more times.

Next Round: With A, Knit. Bind off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### FINISHING

Turn piece inside out (wrong side facing). Thread yarn needle with cast on tail, and sew cast on end closed. Fill with plastic pellets up to Round 7. Cut a long tail with **B**. thread varn needle and sew across Round 10 through both thicknesses to keep the pellets in place. Sew through both thicknesses across Round 16 (with no pellets between Rounds 10 and 16). Stuff remainder of piece with pellets, up to ½" (12.7 mm) from top. Create a triangle by joining left and right top corners as shown. Thread varn needle with remaining tail and sew top edge closed. Fasten securely; weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = workdirections in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
