# What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver Ombre™: 3 skeins 4975 Sweet Treat A; 2 skeins 3966 Jazzy B

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6 mm [US 10] and 6.5 mm [US 10.5]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" (10 cm) 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Ridge Pattern on larger needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge



RED HEART\* Super Saver Ombre™, Art E305,

available in print colors 10 oz (283 g), 482 yd (440 m) skeins



Alternate two shades of Ombre yarn and add vivacious color to your favorite resting spot. Each panel is knit separately, like a scarf, and then sewn together.

Throw measures 55" x 55" (139.5 cm x 139.5 cm)

#### **Notes**

- Throw is worked in 5 panels: 1 Left Edge panel, 3 Center panels and 1 Right Edge panel.
- The Left Edge, Right Edge and one Center panel are worked in color A. The two Center panels are worked in color B.
- After completing the panels, they are sewn together along the long edges to form the Throw.

#### SPECIAL STITCH

kfb (knit into the front and back of next stitch) = Knit the next stitch on the left hand needle and before taking it off the needle, insert the tip of your working needle into the backside of the same stitch and knit it through the back loop. Then transfer the 2 stitches to the right hand needle - 1 st increased.

## **PATTERN STITCH**

## Ridge Pattern (multiple of 2 stitches)

**Note:** Stitch count increases on Row 2 and decreases on Row 3.

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

**Row 2:** P1, \*k2tog; repeat from \* to last stitch, p1.

**Row 3:** K1, \*kfb; repeat from \* to last stitch, k1.

Row 4: Purl.

Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern.

# THROW LEFT EDGE PANEL

With smaller needles and **A**, cast on 48 sts.

Knit 3 rows, ending after a wrong side row

Change to larger needles.

Row 1 (right side): K2, work Row 1 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2.

54" (137 cm), ending after a wrong side row.

Change to smaller needles and knit 4

rows.

over center 44 stitches, k1, p1.

over center 44 stitches, k1, p1.

over center 44 stitches, k2.

Bind off all sts knitwise.

# CENTER PANEL (make 1 panel A and 2 panels B)

Row 2: K2, work Row 2 of Ridge pattern

Row 3: K2, work Row 3 of Ridge pattern

Row 4: K2, work Row 4 of Ridge pattern

Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures

With smaller needles, cast on 48 sts. Knit 3 rows, ending after a wrong side row.

Change to larger needles.

Row 1 (right side): K2, work Row 1 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2

**Row 2:** P1, k1, work Row 2 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k1, p1.

**Row 3:** K2, work Row 3 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2.

**Row 4:** P1, k1, work Row 4 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k1, p1.

Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures 54" (137 cm) ending after a wrong side

Change to smaller needles and knit 4 rows.

Bind off all sts knitwise, leaving a tail 60" (152.5 cm) long for seaming.

SHOP KIT



### **RIGHT EDGE PANEL**

With smaller needles and **A**, cast on 48 sts.

Knit 3 rows, ending after a wrong side row.

Change to larger needles.

**Row 1 (right side):** K2, work Row 1 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2.

**Row 2:** P1, k1, work Row 2 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2.

**Row 3:** K2, work Row 3 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2.

**Row 4:** P1, k1, work Row 4 of Ridge pattern over center 44 stitches, k2. Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures 54" (137 cm), ending after a wrong side row.

Change to smaller needles and knit 4 rows.

Bind off all sts knitwise, leaving a tail 60" (152.5 cm) long for seaming.

## **FINISHING**

Sew panels together using tails left after binding off and following layout diagram.

Weave in ends.

**k =** knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
