## What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:** 3 skeins 1542 Aubergine **A** and 6 skeins 1978 Baroque Stripe **B**

**Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needle:** 6.5mm [US 10½], 29" [74 cm] long

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4" [10 cm];  
24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter stitch slightly stretched.  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.



**RED HEART® With Love®**, Art. E400 available in solid color 7oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m), multicolor 5oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) and stripes 5 oz (141 g) 223 yds (204 m) skeins

# Four-Square Diagonal Throw

This dramatic design is knit in four squares, with each square being knit from corner to corner. Use the auto-stripping shade of cozy With Love yarn for interesting colorations without having a lot of ends to join.

**Finished Throw measures 48" [122 cm] x 48" [122 cm].**

## NOTE

Throw is made up of 4 Squares which are sew together. Squares are worked diagonally, starting in first corner, increasing sts until diagonal center of Square has been reached, making 2 corners. Then sts are decreased to make last corner.

## THROW

With **A**, cast on 4 sts.

Increase section

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** K2, yo, k2.

**Row 2 (RS):** K3, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** K3, yo, k3.

**Row 4:** K3, yo, knit to end.

Repeat Row 4 until there are 125 sts on last row worked.

## Decrease section

Change to **B**.

**Next Row:** K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, knit to end.

Repeat last row until 9 sts remain on last row worked.

**Next Row:** K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, k2 - 8 sts.

**Next Row:** K3, yo, [k2tog] twice, k1 - 7 sts.

**Next Row:** K3, yo, [k2tog] twice - 6 sts.

**Next Row:** K2, [k2tog] twice - 4 sts.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Positioning **B** sections in center, sew 4 squares together. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **yo** = yarn over; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



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
