#### **MATERIALS**

**Red Heart® Super Saver® Jumbo™** (10 oz/283 g; 482 yds/440 m) 4 balls or 1684 yds/1540 m Macaw (3944)

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> knitting needles and 36" [91 cm] Susan Bates® long circular knitting needle (for border) or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle.





#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Approx =  $\mathbf{Kfb} = Increase$ Rnd(s) = Round(s)**RS** = Right side Approximately 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of **Tog** = Together  $\mathbf{K} = Knit$ **K2tog** = Knit next next stitch 2 stitches together **Rem** = Remain(ing)

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 40" x 52" [101.5 x 133 cm], excluding border.

## GAUGE

16 sts and 32 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in garter st.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Notes:

- Throw is made from 20 Squares sewn together following assembly diagram.
- Each Square is worked diagonally from corner to corner.
- After Squares are sewn together, borders are worked along all four edges of throw and then diagonal corner edges of the borders are sewn together.

# **SQUARE** (make 20)

With pair of straight needles, cast on 1 st.

# Increase Section

1st row: (RS). Kfb. 2 sts. **2nd row:** Kfb. K1. 3 sts. **3rd row:** Kfb. K2. 4 sts. **4th row:** Kfb. K3. 5 sts.

5th-61st rows: Kfb. Knit to end of

row. 62 sts.

# **Decrease Section**

62nd -121st rows: K2tog. Knit to

end of row. 2 sts rem.

**122nd row:** K2tog. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Arrange Squares in a grid 4 Squares wide and 5 Squares tall following the assembly diagram on page 2, and sew Squares tog.



# **CRED HEART** DIAGONAL SQUARES KNITTHROW

**Top Border:** With RS facing and circular needle, pick up and knit 112 sts evenly spaced along top (short edge) of Throw. **Do not** join in rnd. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

**1st row:** Kfb. Knit to end of row. 113 sts.

**2nd - 12th rows:** Kfb. Knit to end of row. 124 sts. Cast off loosely.

## **Lower Border**

Work same as Top Border along lower edge of Throw.

## **Side Borders**

With RS facing and circular needle, pick up and knit 142 sts evenly spaced along one side edge of Throw.

**1st row:** Kfb. Knit to end of row. 143 sts.

**2nd - 12th rows:** Kfb. Knit to end of row. 154 sts.

Cast off loosely.

Repeat Side Border along rem side edge. Sew diagonal corner edges of Borders tog.

Weave in ends.
