What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Snuggle Bunny™: 5 balls 9982 Goldfish

Susan Bates[®] Circular Knitting Needles: 8mm [US 11] 29" long

Yarn Needle, stitch markers

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette Stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Rocking Waves Blanket

A restful knit wave pattern combined with the soft, textured yarn is perfect for baby's quiet times. Using this bulky multi-colored yarn means your blanket is wonderfully colorful without needing to change yarn colors. Blanket measures: 36" x 36" square (91 cm x 91 cm)

NOTE

Blanket is worked back and forth in rows on circular needles, do not join.

WAVE PATTERN

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit. Row 2 (Wrong Side): Purl. Row 3: K2tog twice, *(yarn over, K1) 4 times, (K2tog) 4 times; repeat from *, end (yarn over, K1) 4 times, K2tog twice. Row 4: Knit Repeat Rows 1-4 for Wave Pattern.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

K2tog = Knit 2 sts together as one (decrease).YO = Yarn over needle (increase).

BLANKET

Cast on 90 sts. Knit 1 row.

Row 1 (Right Side): K3, place stitch marker, work Wave Pattern to last 3 stitches, place stitch marker, K3. Next Rows: Continue in Wave Pattern knitting first and last 3 stitches, until piece measures 36" [91 cm] from cast on edge and ending with Row 4 of Wave Pattern.

Last Row: Bind off all stitches loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; k2tog = Knit the next two
stitches together; mm = millimeters;
P = purl; st(s) = stitch (es); * = repeat
whatever follows the * as indicated.
