# What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 4 skeins 1801 Navy A and 2 skeins 1805 Bluebell B

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10] circular needle, 29" [73.5 cm] long


Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Mistake Stitch pattern, slightly stretched. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

# Off-to-College **Throw**

Choose school colors for a knit throw the academic or athletic collegiate will appreciate. The ribbed Mistake Stitch pattern is reversible and easy to wrap up in when school housing is drafty.

### Throw measures about 45 x 49" [114.5 x 124.5 cm1

#### **Notes**

- 1. Throw is worked back and forth in
- 2. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

## **THROW**

With A, cast on 223 sts. Row 1 (right side): \*K2, p2; repeat from \* to last 3 sts, k2, p1.

Repeat Row 1, for Mistake Stitch pattern, working with A for 6" [15 cm], then B for 2" [5 cm], \*A for 5" [12.5 cm], B for 2" [5 cm]; repeat from \* 4 more times, and A for 6" [15 cm]. Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A and B = Color A and Color C; k = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
