What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Stellar"' 8 oz: 2 balls each 9201 Galaxy A and 9949 Star B
or
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Stellar"': 4 balls each 9201 Galaxy A and 9949 Star B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circ}$ Circular Knitting Needles: 10 mm [US 15] 32" long

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 6 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}] ; 12$ rows = $4^{" ~}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in K1, *P1, K1* stitch pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge. Exact gauge is not necessary for this project.

RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Stellar"' 8 oz, Art E843 available in 8 oz (226 g) 160 yds ( 146 m ) balls
or


RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Stellar"', Art E811 available in $4 \mathrm{oz}(113 \mathrm{~g}) 80 \mathrm{yd}$ ( 73 m) balls


## Natural Beauty Throw

This soft, lofty yarn has wonderful texture and a small thread of metallic. The look and feel is relaxing and it knits up quickly since it is a super bulky yarn.

## Throw measures: $45^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 551 / 2$ " long [ $114 \mathrm{~cm} \times 140 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## Notes

Circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of bulky stitches. Do not join, work back and forth in rows.

## SPECIAL STITCH

P1, K1: Purl one st, knit 1 st.

## THROW

With A, cast on 67 sts
Row 1 (Right Side): K1, *p1, k1* across row.
Next Rows: Repeat Row 1 following Stripe
Pattern until piece measures $55 \frac{1}{2}$ " [ 141 cm ] from cast on edge. Bind off all sts loosely.

## STRIPE PATTERN

With A, work for 6" [15 cm ] With B, work for $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}[14 \mathrm{~cm}]$ With A, work for 5 " $[13 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] With B, work for $4 /{ }^{\prime \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}[11 \mathrm{~cm}]$ With A, work for $31 / 2 \prime$ " 9 cm ] With B, work for $21 / 2 \prime 2[6 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] With A, work for $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2[4 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] With B, work for $2 \frac{1}{2} "[6 \mathrm{~cm}]$ With A, work for $31 / 2 \prime 2[9 \mathrm{~cm}]$ With B, work for $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ [ 11 cm ] With A, work for 5 " $[13 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] With B, work for $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}[14 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] With A, work for 6" ${ }^{\prime \prime} 15 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in ends.
