What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ With Love ${ }^{\circ}$ : 3 skeins 1909 Holly Berry

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circ}$ Circular Knitting Needles: 6.0mm [US 10] 36" long

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 17 sts = 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$; 17 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Wave Pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ With Love, Art. E 400 available in solid color 7 oz (198g), 370 yd (338m) and multicolor $50 \mathrm{z}(141 \mathrm{~g}), 230 \mathrm{yd}$ (211m) skeins.


## Reversible Wave Throw

Cuddle up in front of the fireplace wrapped in this wonderful wave stitch throw. It has the added advantage of being reversible! And it's the perfect gift for someone who has everything!

## Throw measures 44 " wide $\times 56$ " long [ $112 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## SPECIAL STITICHES

$\mathbf{K 2} \mathbf{t o g}=$ Knit 2 sts together.
ssk = Slip, slip, knit. Slip next two stitches one at a time knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through the back loop. SI $1=$ Slip 1 st purlwise with yarn to the back at beginning of each row.
$\mathbf{K 1 t b l}=$ Knit 1 st through the back loop. P1tbl $=$ Purl 1 st through the back loop.

## NOTE

Throw is worked back and forth in rows on circular needles to accommodate the large number of stitches. Do not join. When working Wave Pattern, the stitch count remains the same on every row-125 sts.

## TIPS \& HINTS

Join a new ball of yarn when there are approximately 6 " [ 15 cm ] of yarn left from the old ball, also leaving a $6^{\prime \prime}[15 \mathrm{~cm}]$ tail of yarn with the joined yarn. Weave these ends in neatly on the wrong side of the fabric in a zigzag pattern for a few inches, and then trim off excess.

## THROW

Cast on 125 sts.
Work in Wave Pattern until piece measures $56^{\prime \prime}$ [ 142 cm ] from cast on edge- 246 Rows total.

## Wave Pattern

Row 1 (Right Side): Sl 1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, knit until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1-125 sts
Row 2 (Wrong Side): SI 1, p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, knit until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice-125 sts

Row 3: Repeat Row 1
Row 4: Sl 1, ${ }^{*}$ p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, purl until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice-125 sts
Row 5: Sl 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p5, k2tog, yo; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1-125 sts.
Row 6: Sl 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p2, k5; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 7: Sl 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p4, k2tog, k1, yo; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 8: SI 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p3, k4; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 9: SI 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p3, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 10: Sl 1, ${ }^{*}$ p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p4, k3; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 11: Sl 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p2, k2tog, k3, yo; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 12: Sl 1, "p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p5, k2; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice.
Row 13: Sl 1, *[k1tbl, p1] twice, k2tog, k4, yo; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 14: Sl 1, ${ }^{*}$ p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p6, k1; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice.
Row 15: SI 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k2tog, k5, yo; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 16: Sl 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p7; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice.

Row 17: Sl 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, ssk, p5; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 18: Sl 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, k5, p2; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 19: SI 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k1, ssk, p4; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 20: SI 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, k4, p3; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 21: SI 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k2, ssk, p3; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 22: SI 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, k3, p4; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 23: Sl 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k3, ssk, p2; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 24: Sl 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, k2, p5; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 25: SI 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k4, ssk, p1; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 26: SI 1, *[p1tbl, k1] twice, p6; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice. Row 27: Sl 1, *k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k5, ssk; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Row 28: Sl 1, *p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p7; repeat from * until 4 sts remain; [p1tbl, k1] twice.
Rows 29-244: Repeat Rows 5-28, nine more times.
Rows 245-246: Repeat Rows 1-2. On Row 2, bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block lightly.

$\mathbf{K}=$ knit; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl; $\mathbf{s t}=$ slip stitch; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; $\mathbf{t o g}=$ together; $\mathbf{y o}=$ yarn over needle; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the ${ }^{*}$ or ${ }^{* *}$ as indicated.
