What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Mixology Swirl": 3 balls 9959 Retro A RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Mixology Prints ${ }^{\text {" }}$ : 3 balls 959 Retro Print B RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Mixology Solids ${ }^{\prime \prime}$ : 2 balls each of 102 Ivory C, 631 Jade D and 263 Coral E.

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circ}$ Knitting Needles: 12.75 mm [US 17] circular needle, $24^{\prime \prime}$ $(60 \mathrm{~cm})$ or longer

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 18 sts $=9 "(23 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 8$ rows $=3^{\prime \prime}(7.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

## Retro Knit Throw

The pattern may be retro, but it has been combined with thoroughly modern bulky weight yarn for a smashing look for today! You'll love choosing your favorite colors from the Mixology palettes of colors in coordinating Solids, Prints and textural Swirl.

## Throw measures $40^{\prime \prime}$ ( 101.5 cm ) wide $\times 55$ " $(140 \mathrm{~cm})$ long.

## Stripe Sequence

Work * 4 rows with D, 4 rows with $\mathbf{A}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{E}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{C}, 8$ rows with $\mathbf{B}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{C}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{A}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{E}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{D}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{A}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{C}, 8$ rows with $\mathbf{B}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{C}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{D}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{A}^{* *}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{E}$, work in reverse from ${ }^{* *}$ back to * for a total of 140 rows in sequence.

## THROW

With A, cast on 80 sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.
Knit 4 rows.
Change to D.
Row 1 (right side): Knit.
Row 2: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.
Row 3: K4, *[k2tog] 3 times, [yarn over, k1] 6 times, [k2tog] 3 times; repeat from * to last 4 sts, k 4 .
Row 4: Knit.
Change to $\mathbf{A}$
Repeat Rows 1-4 and continue to change color as in Stripe Sequence for all 140 rows of sequence.
With A, knit 4 rows.
Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B , C, D, and $\mathbf{E}=$ Color A, Color B, Color C, Color D, and Color E.; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit next 2 stitches together; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * $=$ repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
