What you will need:

RED HEART® Mixology Swirl™:

3 balls 9959 Retro A

RED HEART® Mixology Prints™:

3 balls 959 Retro Print B

RED HEART® Mixology Solids™:

2 balls each of 102 Ivory C, 631 Jade D and 263 Coral E.

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:

12.75mm [US 17] circular needle, 24" (60 cm) or longer

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 18 sts = 9" (23 cm); 8 rows = 3" (7.5 cm) in pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Retro Knit Throw

The pattern may be retro, but it has been combined with thoroughly modern bulky weight yarn for a smashing look for today! You'll love choosing your favorite colors from the Mixology palettes of colors in coordinating Solids, Prints and textural Swirl.

Throw measures 40" (101.5 cm) wide x 55" (140 cm) long.

Stripe Sequence

Work * 4 rows with **D**, 4 rows with **A**, 4 rows with **E**, 4 rows with **C**, 8 rows with **B**, 4 rows with **C**, 4 rows with **A**, 4 rows with **E**, 4 rows with **D**, 4 rows with **A**, 4 rows with **C**, 8 rows with **B**, 4 rows with **C**, 4 rows with **D**, 4 rows with **A** **, 4 rows with **E**, work in reverse from ** back to * for a total of 140 rows in sequence.

THROW

With **A**, cast on 80 sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

Knit 4 rows.

Change to **D**.

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

Row 2: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 3: K4, *[k2tog] 3 times, [yarn over, k1] 6 times, [k2tog] 3 times; repeat from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 4: Knit.

Change to **A**.

Repeat Rows 1–4 and continue to change color as in Stripe Sequence for all 140 rows of sequence.

With **A**, knit 4 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **A, B, C, D,** and **E** = Color A, Color B, Color C, Color D, and Color E; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 stitches together; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
