What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ With Love ${ }^{\circledR}$ : 2 skeins each of 1907 Boysenberry A, 1252 Mango B, 1623 Mallard C, 1601 Lettuce D, 1302 Caramel E.

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Knitting Needles: 5.5 mm [US 9]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 16 sts $=4 "(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 22$ rows $=4 "(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

(c) 4 aRED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ With Love ${ }^{\circledR}$, Art. E400 available in solid color $70 z$ (198g), $370 \mathrm{yd}(338 \mathrm{~m})$ and multicolor 50 z ( 141 g ), 230 yd (211m) skeins


## Sampler Block Throw

Enjoy some new knitting stitch patterns as you create this cozy throw. Our 4 blocks are given as a written pattern and are charted. This is a great project to take along on a trip or to have with you when you have waiting time.

## Throw measures $50 \times 60$ " ( $127 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Special Stitch

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.

## Pattern Stitches

## Seed Stitch (over even number of sts)

Row 1 (right side): *K1, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: Purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts as they appear.
Repeat last row for Seed st.
Moss Diamonds (multiple of 10 sts + 9)
Row 1 (right side): K4, *p1, k9; repeat from * to last 5 sts, p1, k4.
Row 2: P3, *k1, p1, k1, p7; repeat from * to last 6 sts, k1, p1, k1, p3.
Row 3: K2, *[p1, k1] twice, p1, k5; repeat from * to last 7 sts, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k2.

Row 4: [P1, k1] 4 times, *p3, [k1, p1] 3 times, k1; repeat from * to last st, p1.
Row 5: P1, *k1, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 6: Repeat Row 4.
Row 7: Repeat Row 3.
Row 8: Repeat Row 2.
Row 9: Repeat Row 1.
Row 10: Purl.
Repeat Rows 1-10 for Moss Diamonds pattern.

## Broken Rib (over odd number of sts)

Row 1 (right side): K1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: Purl.
Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for Broken Rib pattern.

## Zigzag Moss (multiple of 6 sts + 1)

Row 1 (right side): Knit.
Row 2: Purl.
Row 3: P1, *k5, p1; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 4: P1, *k1, p3, k1, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Rows 5 and 6: P1, *k1, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 7: K2, p1, k1, p1, *k3, p1, k1, p1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 8: P3, k1, *p5, k1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, p3.
Row 9: Knit.
Row 10: Purl.
Row 11: K3, p1, *k5, p1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3.
Row 12: P2, k1, p1, k1, *p3, k1, p1, k1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, p2.
Rows 13 and 14: K1, *p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 15: K1, *p1, k3, p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 16: K1, *p5, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Repeat Rows 1-16 for Zigzag Moss pattern.
Square Lattice (multiple of 14 sts + 2)
Row 1 (right side): Knit.
Row 2: P2, *[k1, p1] twice, k1, p2; repeat from

* to end of row.

Row 3: K3, *p1, k1, p1, k4; repeat from * to last 6 sts, p1, k1, p1, k3.
Rows 4-7: Repeat last 2 rows 2 more times
Row 8: P2, *k12, p2; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 9: K2, *p12, k2; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 10: Purl.
Row 11: K2, *[p1, k1] twice, p1, k2; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 12: P3, *k1, p1, k1, p4; repeat from * to last 6 sts, k1, p1, k1, p3.
Rows 13-16: Repeat last 2 rows 2 more times. Row 17: P7, *k2, p12; repeat from * to last 9 sts, k2, p7.
Row 18: K7, *p2, k12; repeat from * to last 9
sts, p2, k7.
Repeat Rows 1-18 for Square Lattice pattern.

## Vertical Zigzag (multiple of 9 sts)

Row 1 (right side): *[K1, p1] twice, k4, p1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 2: *P4, [k1, p1] twice, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 3: [K1, p1] 3 times, *k4, [p1, k1] twice, p1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3.
Row 4: P2, *[k1, p1] twice, k1, p4; repeat from

* to last 7 sts, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2.

Row 5: K3, *[p1, k1] twice, p1,k4; repeat from

* to last 6 sts, [p1, k1] 3 times.

Row 6: *[K1, p1] twice, k1, p4; repeat from * to end of row.
Row 7: Repeat Row 5
Row 8: Repeat Row 4
Row 9: Repeat Row 3.
Row 10: Repeat Row 2
Repeat Rows 1 -10 for Vertical Zigzag pattern.

## Notes

1. Throw is made from five panels.
2. Each panel consists of 4 blocks, each measuring about $10 \times 15$ " $(25.5 \times 38 \mathrm{~cm})$.
3. Seed st borders are worked around outer edges and between blocks.
4. Panels are sewn together to form throw.

## PANEL 1

With A, cast on 40 sts

## Block 1 (Moss Diamonds)

Work in Seed st for $1^{\prime \prime}(2.5 \mathrm{~cm})$, end with a wrong side row.

## Begin Moss Diamonds Pattern

Row 1 (right side): Work in Seed st over first 5 sts, k1, place marker, work Row 1 of Moss Diamonds pattern over next 29 sts, place
marker, work in Seed st over last 5 sts.
Row 2: Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker, work next row of Moss Diamonds pattern to next marker, slip marker, p1, work in Seed st to end of row.
Row 3: Work in Seed st to 1 st before marker, k1, slip marker, work next row of Moss Diamonds pattern to next marker, slip marker, work in Seed st to end of row.
Repeat last 2 rows, working next row of Moss Diamonds pattern in each row, until block 1 measures about $14^{\prime \prime}(35.5 \mathrm{~cm})$, end with a wrong side row. Remove markers.
Work in Seed st until block 1 measures about 15 " $(38 \mathrm{~cm})$, end with a right side row. Cut A.

## Block 2 (Broken Rib)

Next Row (wrong side): With B, purl.
Work in Seed st for 1 " ( 2.5 cm ), end with a right side row.
Increase Row (wrong side): Work in Seed st over first 20 sts, M1, work in Seed st to end of row-41 sts.

## Begin Broken Rib Pattern

Row 1 (right side): Work in Seed st over first 5 sts, place marker, work Row 1 of Broken Rib pattern over next 31 sts, place marker, work in Seed st over last 5 sts.
Row 2: Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker, work next row of Broken Rib pattern to next marker, slip marker, work in Seed st to end of row.
Repeat last row, working next row of Broken Rib pattern in each row, until block 2
measures about 14 " ( 35.5 cm ), end with a right side row.
Decrease Row (wrong side): Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker, p14, p2tog, p15, slip marker, work in Seed st to end of row-40 sts. Remove markers.
Work in Seed st for 1 " ( 2.5 cm ), end with a right side row. Cut $\mathbf{B}$.

## Block 3 (Zigzag Moss)

Next Row (wrong side): With C, purl.
Work in Seed st for 1 " ( 2.5 cm ), end with a right side row.
Decrease Row (wrong side): [Work in Seed st over 12 sts, k2tog] twice, work in Seed st to end of row-38 sts.

## Begin Zigzag Moss Pattern

Row 1 (right side): Work in Seed st over first 5 sts, k2, place marker, work Row 1 of Zigzag Moss pattern over next 25 sts, place marker, k1, work in Seed st over last 5 sts.
Row 2: Work in Seed st to 1 st before marker, p1, slip marker, work next row of Zigzag Moss pattern to next marker, slip marker, p2, work in Seed st to end of row.
Row 3: Work in Seed st to 2 sts before marker, k2, slip marker, work next row of Zigzag Moss pattern to next marker, slip marker, k1, work in Seed st to end of row.
Repeat last 2 rows, working next row of Zigzag Moss pattern in each row, until block 3 measures about 14" ( 35.5 cm ), end with a right side row.
Increase Row (wrong side): Work in Seed st to 1 st before marker, p1, slip marker, [work in Zigzag Moss pattern over 8 sts, M11 twice, work in Zigzag Moss pattern to next marker, slip marker, p2, work in Seed st to end of row-40 sts. Remove markers.
Work in Seed st for 1 " ( 2.5 cm ), end with a right side row. Cut C.

## Block 4 (Square Lattice)

Next Row (wrong side): With D, purl.
Work in Seed st until piece measures 1 " (2.5 $\mathrm{cm})$ from beginning, end with a wrong side row.

## Begin Square Lattice Pattern

Row 1 (right side): Work in Seed st over first
5 sts, place marker, work Row 1 of Square Lattice pattern over next 30 sts, place marker,
work in Seed st over last 5 sts.
Row 2: Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker, work next row of Square Lattice pattern to next marker, slip marker, work in Seed st to end of row.
Repeat last row, working next row of Square Lattice pattern in each row, until block 4 measures about 14 " ( 35.5 cm ), end with a wrong side row. Remove markers.
Work in Seed st until piece measures about 15 " $(38 \mathrm{~cm})$ from beginning, end with a wrong side row.
Bind off as if to knit.

## PANEL 2

## Block 1 (Vertical Zigzag)

With E , cast on 40 sts.
Work in Seed st until piece measures 1 " (2.5 cm ) from beginning, end with a right side row. Decrease Row (wrong side): [Work in Seed st over 8 sts, k2tog] 3 times, work in Seed st to end of row-37 sts.

## Begin Vertical Zigzag Pattern

Row 1 (right side): Work in Seed st over first 5 sts, place marker, work Row 1 of Vertical Zigzag pattern over next 27 sts, place marker, work in Seed st over last 5 sts.
Row 2: Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker, work next row of Vertical Zigzag pattern to next marker, slip marker, work in Seed st to end of row.
Repeat last row, working next row of Vertical Zigzag pattern in each row, until piece measures about 14 " $(35.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ from beginning, end with a right side row. Increase Row (wrong side): Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker, [work in Vertical Zigzag pattern over 7 sts, M1] 3 times, work in Vertical Zigzag pattern to next marker, slip marker, work in Seed st to end of row-40 sts. Remove markers.

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Work in Seed st until piece measures about 15 " ( 38 cm ) from beginning, end with a right side row. Cut E .

## Block 2 (Moss Diamonds)

Next Row (wrong side): With A, purl.
Work same as Block 1 of Panel 1.

## Block 3 (Broken Rib)

Work same as Block 2 of Panel 1.

## Block 4 (Zigzag Moss)

Work same as Block 3 of Panel 1.
Bind off as if to knit.

## PANEL 3

## Block 1 (Square Lattice)

With D, cast on 40 sts.
Work same as Block 4 of Panel 1, end with a right side row. Do not bind off.

## Block 2 (Vertical Zigzag)

Next Row (wrong side): With E, purl.
Work same as Block 1 of Panel 2, beginning at irst Seed st section.

## Block 3 (Moss Diamonds)

Next Row (wrong side): With A, purl
Work same as Block 1 of Panel 1 beginning at first Seed st section.

## Block 4 (Broken Rib)

Work same as Block 2 of Panel 1.
Bind off as if to knit.

## PANEL 4

Block 1 (Zigzag Moss)
With C, cast on 40 sts.
Work same as Block 3 of Panel 1.

## Block 2 (Square Lattice)

Work same as Block 4 of Panel 1, end with a right side row. Do not bind off

## Block 3 (Vertical Zigzag)

Next Row (wrong side): With E, purl.
Work same as Block 1 of Panel 2 beginning at first Seed st section.

## Block 4 (Moss Diamonds)

Next Row (wrong side): With A, purl
Work same as Block 1 of Panel 1 beginning at first Seed st section
Bind off as if to knit.

## PANEL 5

Block 1 (Broken Rib)
With B, cast on 40 sts.
Work same as Block 2 of Panel 1.

## Block 2 (Zigzag Moss)

Work same as Block 3 of Panel 1.

## Block 3 (Square Lattice)

Work same as Block 4 of Panel 1, end with a right side row. Do not bind off.

## Block 4 (Vertical Zigzag)

Next Row (wrong side): With E, purl.
Work same as Block 1 of Panel 2 beginning at first Seed st section. Bind off as if to knit.

## FINISHING

With right side facing, arrange panels in the following order: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5. Sew long edges of panels together. Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit next 2 sts together; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; p2tog = purl next 2 sts together; st(s) = sttich(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * $=$ repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
