What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Soft™: 2 skeins of 4608 Wine.

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needle: 9 mm [US-13] - 36" (91 cm).

Cable needle.

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4½" (11 cm), 15 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Fans and Cables Throw

Update a classic! Knit this fans and cable pattern in a rich jewel color for a cozy throw that warms a chilly evening.

Finished Size: 45" (114 cm) wide x 60" (152 cm) long

Special Stitches

Increase – Purl into the front and the back of the next stitch (1 stitch increase).

Twist (uses 3 sts)— Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K1 from the left needle, K2 tog from the cable needle (1 stitch decrease).

Decrease – Slip next stitch knitwise onto right needle, then knit the next two stitches together. With the left needle, lift the slipped stitch over the stitch just made (2 stitch decrease).

THROW

With 2 strands held together, cast on 131 sts. Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Rows 2-5: Knit across.

Row 6: K5, P1, work increase, K2, *P 11, K2, P1, work increase, K2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts. K3: 139 sts.

Row 7: K3, P2, work twist, P2, *yo, K4, work decrease, K4, yo, P2, work twist, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 131 sts.

Row 8: K5, P1, yo, P1, K2, *P 11, K2, P1, yo, P1, K2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 139 sts.

Row 9: (K3, P2) twice, *K1, yo, K3, work decrease, K3, yo, K1, P2, K3, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 139 sts.

Row 10: K5, P3, K2, *P 11, K2, P3, K2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 11: K3, P2, work twist, P2, * K2, yo, K2, work decrease, K2, yo, K2, P2, work twist, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 131 sts.

Row 12: Repeat Row 8: 139 sts.

Row 13: (K3, P2) twice, *K3, yo, K1, work decrease, K1, yo, K3, P2, K3, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 139 sts.

Row 14: Repeat Row 10.

Row 15: K3, P2, work twist, P2, *K4, yo, work

decrease, yo, K4, P2, work twist, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 131 sts. Row 16: K5, P1, yo, P1, K2, *K 13, P1, yo, P1, K2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 139 sts

Row 17: (K3, P2) twice, *yo, K4, work decrease, K4, yo, P2, K3, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 139 sts.

Row 18: Repeat Row 10.

Row 19: K3, P2, work twist, P2, *K1, yo, K3, work decrease, K3, yo, K1, P2, work twist, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 131 sts.

Row 20: Repeat Row 8: 139 sts.

Row 21: (K3, P2) twice, *K2, yo, K2, work decrease, K2, yo, K2, P2, K3, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 22: Repeat Row 10.

Row 23: K3, P2, work twist, P2, *K3, yo, K1, work decrease, K1, yo, K3, P2, work twist, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 131 sts.

Row 24: Repeat Row 8: 139 sts.

Row 25: (K3, P2) twice, *K4, yo, work decrease, yo, K4, P2, K3, P2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3: 139 sts.

Row 26: K5, P3, K2, *K 13, P3, K2; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, K3.

Repeat Rows 7-26 for pattern until Throw measures approximately 59" from cast on edge, or to desired length, ending by working Row 15 or 23: 131 sts.

Next 4 Rows: Knit across.

Bind off all sts in knit.

K = knit; mm = millimeter; P = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; () = work directions in parentheses as indicated.
