

## Pack-a-ghan

This afghan is created with easy-to-knit rectangles that are crocheted together. It's a superb idea for taking to sports events or for keeping in the car for picnics. When folded, it's easy to carry and a comfy seat.

Designed by Grace Alexander.
Throw measures: 38 " $\times 52^{\prime \prime}$.
Folded measurement: $131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 "$.
RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR} 3$ skeins each 387 Soft Navy A and 320 Cornmeal B.

Knitting Needles: 5mm [8 US].
Crochet Hook: 4.5 mm [F].
Yarn needle, 2 size 10 snaps.
GAUGE: 16 sts $=4$ "; 25 rows $=4$ " over pattern st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

## NOTE

Pack-a-ghan is made up of 9 individual rectangles: 5 of Rectangle A, and 4 of Rectangle B.

## PACK-A-GHAN

## Rectangle A (Make 5)

With A cast on 68 sts.
Knit 2 rows.
Change to B, work 2 rows St st.
Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures approx 13", ending with 2nd row of $\mathbf{A}$. Bind off with $\mathbf{A}$.

## Rectangle B (Make 4)

With B cast on 54 sts.
Knit 2 rows.
Change to A, work 2 rows St st.
Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures approx 17", ending with 2nd row of $\mathbf{B}$. Bind off with $\mathbf{B}$.

Sew rectangles as shown in diagram.

## FINISHING

## Edging

With A sc evenly around all 4 edges of Pack-a-ghan working 3 sc into each of the corners; join with a slip st to first sc, change to B, ch 1 , turn, sc into each sc of previous round, working 3 sc into corners; join with a slip st to first sc, ch 1, turn, sc into each sc of previous round, 3 sc into corners, except rectangle 8B; evenly mark off two 5 sc sections along the edge of 8 B , on reaching these sections, ch 5 , skip 5 sc , and work as before; join with a slip st to first sc, change to A, ch 1, turn; work 2 rounds as before except working 5 sc into ch 5 , slip st to first sc, fasten off.

## Loops (Make 2)

With A cast on 6 sts.
Knit until loop measures $31 / 2$ ". Bind off.
Sew loops to lower edge of 2B ensuring that they correspond to openings on 8B. Sew snaps to ends of loops. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters, $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
