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MITERED SQUARES KNIT THROW Designed by Lisa Gentry | KNIT



MATERIALS

Red Heart® **Super Saver Stripes**® (5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m) Candy Stripe (4145) 13 balls

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.





KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

Sm = Slip marker

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48 x 60" [122 x 152.5 cm], excluding pompoms.

GAUGE

16 sts and 30 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in garter st

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Squares are joined to previous squares as they are knit. Refer to Diagram on page 2 for square placement.

PANEL I

Square 1

Cast on 100 sts. 1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: K50. PM. Knit to end of

row.

3rd row: Knit to 2 sts before marker. K2tog. Sm. ssk. Knit to end of row, 98 sts.

4th row: Knit.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until there

are 4 sts rem.

Next row: K2tog. ssk. 2 sts.

Next row: Knit. Cast off. Do not

fasten off last stitch.

Square 2

1st row: (RS). With RS facing and 1 st rem on needle, pick up and K49 sts along left edge of previous square. Cast on 50 sts. 100 sts.

Work as given for Square 1.



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Squares 3-5

Work as given for Square 2. Fasten off last st of Square 5.

PANEL II Square 6

1st row: (RS). Cast on 50 sts. With RS facing, pick up and knit 50 sts along right edge of first square in previous Panel. 100 sts. Work as given for Square 1.

Square 7

1st row: (RS). With RS facing and 1 st rem on needle, pick up and K49 sts along left edge of previous square. Pick up and K50 sts along right edge of next square in previous Panel. 100 sts. Work as given for Square 1.

Squares 8-10

Work as given for Square 7. Fasten off last stitch of Square 10.

PANELS III and IV

Work as given for Panel II.

FINISHIING

Pompom: (make 10). Wind yarn around 3 fingers 70 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to Blanket. Cut loops at both ends and trim to smooth round shape. Sew securely 5 pompoms evenly spaced along each of the short ends of Throw.
