



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

C8B = Slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K4, then K4 from cable needle.

K = Knit

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise

St(s) = Stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 42" x 48" [106.5 x 122 cm].

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 222 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd to 6th rows: Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

7th row: (RS). (K1. P1) twice. K1. *P3. K8. Rep from * to last 8 sts. P4. (K1. P1) twice.

8th row: (K1. P1) twice. K1. *K3. P8. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K4. (P1. K1) twice.

9th to 14th rows: Rep 7th and 8th rows 3 times more.

15th row: (RS). (K1. P1) twice. K1. *P3. C8B. Rep from * to last 8 sts. P4. (K1. P1) twice.

16th row: As 8th row. Rep 7th to 16th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 47" [119.5 cm], ending on a 14th row.

Next row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Next row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. Cast off in pat.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Heat Wave™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 198 yds/181 m)

Seaweed (0660)

7 balls

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 40" [101.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Cable needle.
