## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (approx) 50" x 581/2" [127 x 148.5 cm ].

## GAUGE

10 sts and 18 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter stitch with 2 strands held together (tog).

## INSTRUCTIONS

With MC and A held tog, cast on 125 stitches (sts). Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 22 rows (garter st), noting first row is Right Side (RS).
With MC and B, knit 22 rows. With $M C$ and $C$, knit 22 rows. With MC and D, knit 22 rows. With MC and E, knit 22 rows. With MC and F, knit 22 rows. With MC and G, knit 22 rows. With MC and H , knit 22 rows. With MC and I, knit 22 rows. With MC and J, knit 22 rows. With MC and $K$, knit 22 rows. With MC and L, knit 22 rows. Cast off knitwise.
