What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Bunches of Hugs ${ }^{\text {TM }: ~} 2$ balls 5311 Chalk A, 1 ball 6381 Dragon B

Susan Bates Circular Knitting Needles: 8mm [US 11] 29" [74 cm]

Susan Bates Double-Pointed Needles: 8mm [US 11]

Susan Bates Crochet Hook: 8 mm (US L-11)

Detachable stitch markers, yarn needle, sturdy cardboard $4 "$ [10 cm] square

GAUGE: 10 sts $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Double Garter Stitch pattern with 4 strands of yarn held together. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.


RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Bunches of Hugs ${ }^{\text {TM }}$, Art. E866 OekoTex Certified 100\% Acrylic baby yarn available in solid 14 oz ( 397 g ), 948 yd ( 868 m ) and print 10 oz (284 g), 678 yd ( 620 m ) balls

## Fringed Knit Basket

Give a shower gift in a knit basket that will help organize baby's things for many years! Holding multiple strands together makes the basket sturdier. And using a multi-color for the fringe means the colors coordinate effortlessly.

Fringed Basket measures: About 14" wide $\times 14^{\prime \prime}$ high [ $35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 35 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] and $42^{\prime \prime}$ [107 cm] in circumference.

## NOTES

1. Fringed Basket is worked from top to bottom center.
2. Use Double-Pointed needles when there are too few stitches for Circular needles.
3. Wind both balls of $\mathbf{A}$ into 2 separate balls. 4 strands of $\mathbf{A}$ are held together to knit Basket.

## Special Stitch

K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together as one

## BASKET

With 4 strands of $\mathbf{A}$ held together and using Circular needles, cast on 111 sts.
Place Stitch Marker on needle to mark the beginning of the Round. Join, being careful not to twist stitches.
Rounds 1-2: Purl.
Rounds 3-4: Knit.
Rounds 5-6: Purl.

## Split for Handles

Next Round: K19, bind off 17 sts, knit next 38 sts, bind off
next 17 sts, knit 20 sts to Stitch
Marker-77 sts.
Next Round: K19, cast on14 sts over bound off sts, knit
next 38 sts, cast on 14 sts over bound off sts, knit 20 sts to
Stitch Marker-105 sts

## Sides of Basket

Rounds 1-2: Purl.
Rounds 3-4: Knit.
Rounds 5-6: Purl.
Round 7: Knit.
Round 8: *K8, p7* 7 times-105 sts.
Round 9: Knit.
Rounds 10-11: Purl
Rounds 12-13: Knit.

Rounds 14-15: Purl
Round 16: Knit
Round 17: *P7, k8* 7 times-105 sts.
Round 18: Knit
Rounds 19-36: Repeat Rounds 1-18.
Rounds 37-51: Repeat Rounds 1-15.
Rounds 52-53: Knit.
Rounds 54-55: Purl.

## Base

Round 1 (Decrease Round): *K5, k2tog* around-90 sts.
Rounds 2-3: Purl.
Round 4: Knit.
Round 5 (Decrease Round): *K4, k2tog* around-75 sts.
Rounds 6-7: Purl.
Round 8: Knit.
Round 9 (Decrease Round): *K3, k2tog* around-60 sts
Rounds 10-11: Purl.
Round 12: Knit.
Round 13 (Decrease Round): *K2, k2tog* around-45 sts.
Rounds 14-15: Purl
Round 16: Knit.
Round 17 (Decrease Round): *K1, k2tog* around-30 sts.
Rounds 18-19: Purl.
Round 20: Knit.
Round 21 (Decrease Round): *K2tog* around-15 sts
Rounds 22-23: Purl.

## Round 24: Knit.

Last Round (Decrease Round): *K2tog* to last st, k1-8 sts.
Cut yarn leaving an 18" [46 cm ] tail.
Thread all 4 strands of
yarn into Yarn needle and weave needle through remaining
continued...


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stitches. Pull tightly to close opening at bottom of Basket
and knot securely.

## FRINGE

Wrap B around the 4" [10 cm] square of cardboard to cut $8^{\prime \prime}[20 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] lengths of yarn. Separate strands in 4 separate piles for each color. For each fringe, hold 3 strands of same color yarn together, fold in half and using crochet hook, attach to each of the 6 "bumps" on the top of each place where the P7 were worked. Use photo as a guide for olacement. After all fringe is attached, trim to about $212^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in length.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends.
