# What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby™:** 1 ball each 934 Candy **A**, 709 Bubblegum **B** 

Susan Bates\* Knitting Needles: 6 mm [US 10]

Yarn needle


GAUGE: 13 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 40 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter Stitch (knit every row). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

# Make It Shine Knit Scrubby

If you're looking for a Scrubby with extra scrubbing ability, try this one. The extra thick center is good for getting all your baking and cooking paraphernalia shiny clean!

Scrubby measures:  $4" \times 4"$  in diameter [10 x 10 cm]

#### **NOTES**

Spiraling knit strip form the "Base" for the Posey Scrubby. Contrasting "Centers" are knit separately and affixed to center of Scrubby on both sides.

#### **Garter Stitch**

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit all stitches. Row 2 (Wrong Side): Knit all stitches. Repeat Rows 1-2 for Garter Stitch.

#### **SPECIAL STITCHES**

**k2tog** = Knit two stitches together (decrease).

**kfb =** Knit into front and back of stitch (increase).

**skp =** Slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over (decrease).

### SCRUBBY Base

yarn tail.

With A. cast on 26 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): Skp, k23 sts, kfb—26 sts.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Kfb, k23 sts, k2tog-26 sts.

Rows 3-44: Repeat Rows 1-2. Row 45: Bind off all stitches in knit. Fasten off leaving a 10" [26 cm] long

Seaming Scrubby Base and Closing Sides

Thread yarn needle with tail. Sew the bound off edge to the cast on edge matching up the diagonal ends and forming a tube. Fasten securely. With yarn needle and yarn, and using a running stitch, sew along the edge of the tube on one side. Gather the stitches together and pull tightly until the side is completely closed forming a circular puff. Fasten securely. Repeat on opposite side of tube. Set Scrubby Base aside.

With B, cast on 26 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): Skp, k23 sts, kfb. Row 2 (Wrong Side): Kfb, k23 sts, k2tog.

Rows 3-44: Repeat Rows 1-2.

**Row 45:** Bind off all stitches in Knit. Fasten off leaving a 10" [26 cm] long varn tail.

Repeat instructions for Seaming Scrubby Base and Closing Sides.

#### Center

#### Make 2

With A, cast on 4 sts.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Kfb in each st across row—8 sts.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Kfb in each st across row—16 sts.

Row 3: Kfb in each st across row-32 sts.

**Row 4:** Bind off all stitches loosely in knit.

Fasten off leaving a 10" [26 cm] long varn tail.

Thread yarn needle with yarn tail and sew ends together. Pull tightly to form a circle and tie off. Sew one "Center" in **A** on each side of Posey Scrubby **B**.

#### Make 2

With B, cast on 4 sts.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Kfb in each st across row—8 sts.

**Row 2 (Wrong Side):** Kfb in each st across row—16 sts.

Row 3: Kfb in each st across row—32 sts.

**Row 4:** Bind off all stitches loosely in Knit.

Fasten off leaving a 10" [26 cm] long yarn tail. Thread Yarn Needle with yarn tail and sew ends together. Pull tightly to form a circle and tie off. Sew one

"Center" in **B** on each side of Posey Scrubby **A**.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

2 sts. together; Kfb = Knit into front
and back of stitch (increase); mm =
millimeters; p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es;
Skp = Slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over
