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# What you will need:

RED HEART\* Scrubby Cotton™: 1 ball 7960 Blushing Print

Susan Bates\* Knitting Needles: 4.5mm [US 7]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART\* Scrubby Cotton™, Art. E854 available

in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 145 yd (133 m), prints 3.0 oz (85 g) 121 yds (110 m) balls



# Big Blossom Scrubby

This feminine Scrubby blossom is perfect for bathing. Knit it and enjoy how the 100% cotton fiber gets softer when wet.

**SHOP KIT** 

### Scrubby measures 7" [18 cm] diameter.

#### NOTE

Scrubby is worked in sections, casting on and binding off or increasing or decreasing sts as well as working simple short rows in order to shape each section. Use a knitted-on or cabled cast-on method. Repeats of Section 2 will result in fewer sts in each repeat to narrow sections. Finished sections are curled around and sewn together to form Scrubby.

## SCRUBBY Section 1

Cast on 12 sts.

Set Up Row: Knit.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Cast on 2 sts, knit across.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Cast on 1 st. knit across.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: K8, leaving remaining sts

unworked, turn.

Row 7: Knit to end of row.

Row 8: Bind off 1 st. knit across all sts.

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: Bind off 2 sts, knit across.

Row 11: Knit.

**Row 12:** K6, leaving remaining sts

unworked, turn.

Row 13: Knit to end of row.

Row 14: Knit across all sts.

Repeat Rows 1-14 for 7 times.

## **Section 2**

Row 15: K2, k2tog, knit to end.

Row 16: Cast on 2 sts, knit across.

Row 17: K2, k2tog, knit to end.

Row 18: Cast on 1 st, knit across.

Row 19: Knit.

**Row 20:** K8, leaving remaining sts unworked, turn.

Row 21: Knit to end of row.

Row 22: Bind off 1 st, knit across all sts.

Row 23: Knit.

Row 24: Bind off 2 sts, knit across.



Row 25: Knit.

Row 26: K6, leaving remaining sts

unworked, turn.

Row 27: Knit to end of row.

Row 28: Knit across all sts.

Repeat Rows 1-14 for 3 times.

## Section 3

Repeat Rows 15-28 once. Repeat Rows 1-14 for 7 times.

#### Section 4

Row 29: K2, k2tog, knit across.

Rows 30-32: Knit.

Repeat Rows 29-30 for 3 times.

Knit 1 row.

Bind off, leaving a 36" [91.5 cm] tail.

Thread tail into yarn needle and weave through straight edge of piece.
Evenly gather edge and twist to form blossom and tack in place where desired.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog = knit
2 sts together; mm = millimeters; st(s) =
stitch(es); tog = together.
