What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball each 905 Cherry A and 620 Lime B

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.



yds (71 m) balls

RED HEART® Scrubby™, Art. E833 available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m), prints 3.0 oz (85 g) 78

Tomato Scrubby

Dishes with stuck on tomato sauce easily come clean with the help of this cleverly shaped knit Scrubby! It's the perfect helper for washing stuck on messes in the kitchen. Keep it fresh by machine washing and will quickly air dry.

Scrubby measures 6" [15 cm] x 4½" Γ11.5 cm1.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

kfb: Knit 1 front and back (increase) Knit next st, then knit it through back loop.

TOMATO

With A, cast on 6 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: (Kfb) twice, k2, (kfb) twice - 10

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: (Kfb) twice, k6, (kfb) twice - 14

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: (Kfb) twice, k10, (kfb) twice - 18

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: (Kfb) twice, k14, (kfb) twice - 22

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: (Kfb) twice, k18, (kfb) twice -26 sts.

Rows 11-32: Knit.

Row 33: (K2tog) twice, k18, (k2tog)

twice - 22 sts. Row 34: Knit.

Row 35: (K2tog) twice, k14, (k2tog)

twice - 18 sts.

Row 36: Knit.

Row 37: (K2tog) twice, k10, (k2tog)

twice - 14 sts.

Row 38: Knit.

Row 39: (K2tog) twice, k6, (k2tog)

twice - 10 sts.

Row 40: Knit.

Row 41: (K2tog) twice, k2, (k2tog) twice

- 6 sts.

Bind off.



STEM

With B, cast on 8 sts. TBind off until 1 st remains on needle. cast on 7 sts] 4 times, bind off all sts, leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

With long tail, fold Stem piece so there are 5 sections and sew together. Sew Stem to top of Tomato. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; () = work directions in parenthesis the number of times specified.
