#### What you will need:

**RED HEART**<sup>®</sup> Scrubby<sup>™</sup>: 1 ball each 620 Lime A, 905 Cherry B and 241 Ducky C

Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> Knitting Needles: 3.75mm [US 5]

Yarn needle, matching sewing thread and needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



**RED HEART**<sup>®</sup> Scrubby<sup>™</sup>, Art. E833 available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 vd (85 m), prints 3.0 oz (85 g) 78 yds (71 m) balls



# **Decorate Your Tree Scrubby**

Here's a fun knit for clever stocking stuffers, hostess gifts or to enjoy yourself. This scrubby can be used in the kitchen or bath or anywhere you need a little extra scrubbing power. It washes easily in the washer and dries quickly.

Tree measures  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " [23.5 cm] tall x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " [14 cm] at widest point.

#### NOTE

Each part of Scrubby is made separately and then pieces are sewed together.

#### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

k3tog: Knit 3 sts together. kfb: Knit 1 front and back (increase) Knit next st, then knit it through back loop.

# TREE

**Top of Tree** With **A**, cast on 3 sts. Row 1: [Kfb] in each st – 6 sts. Row 2: Kfb. knit to last st. kfb – 8 sts. Row 3: Knit. Rows 4-11: Repeat Rows 2-3 - 16 sts on last row worked. Rows 12-13: K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog -12 sts on last row worked. Row 14: Knit. Rows 15-17: Repeat Row 2 - 18 sts on last row worked. Row 18: Knit. Rows 19-20: Repeat Row 12 - 14 sts on last row worked. Row 21: Knit. Rows 22-56: Repeat Rows 15-21 for 5 more times - 24 sts on last row worked. Rows 57-59: Repeat Rows 15-17 - 28 sts on last row worked. Row 60: Knit Bind off.

## TREE STAND

With **B**, cast on 15 sts. Knit every row until piece measures 11/2" [4 cm]. Rows 1-4: K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 7 sts on last row worked.

Bind off, leaving a long end.

Center last row along last row of Tree and sew pieces together using long end.

## HANGER

With C, cast on 12 sts. Bind off, leaving a long end. Fold in half and sew ends together. Center ends along first row of Tree and sew pieces together.

#### BALLS

(make 8 each with **B** and **C**) Leaving a long tail, cast on 5 sts. Rows 1-3: Knit. **Row 4:** K2tog, k1, k2tog – 3 sts. Row 5: K3tog. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Thread long end through all corners and pull to gather in a ball. Secure end. Sew balls on Tree with matching sewing thread.

# FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### Abbreviations

**A**, **B**, **C** = Color A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
