What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\text { }}$ Scrubby
Smoothie ${ }^{\text {TM }}: 1$ ball 9373 Brite Pink

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Knitting Needles: 4 mm [US 6]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 22 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$; 26 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Stockinette stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{*}$ Scrubby Smoothie ${ }^{\text {m }}$, Art. E867 available in solids $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g})$, 153 yd ( 140 m ), prints $3.0 \mathrm{oz}(85 \mathrm{~g})$ 131 yds ( 120 m ) balls


## Chevron Dishcloth

Dishcloths are always a great housewarming gift! Make a few in your friends' favorite colors for a gift they'll be able to use often.

## WASHCLOTH

Cast on 39 sts.
Row 1 (Right Side): K1 (edge st), k1, *k3, [p1, k1] 4 times, k1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).

## Row 2 and All Wrong Side Rows: K1

 (edge st), knit the knits and purl the purls as they appear to last st, k1 (edge st).Row 3: K1 (edge st), k1, *k4, p1, k1, p1, k3, p1, k1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 5: K1 (edge st), p1, *k5, p1, k5, p1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 7: K1 (edge st), k1, *p1, k3, p1, k5, p1, k1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 9: K1 (edge st), p1, *k1, p1, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, p1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 11: K1 (edge st), k1, *p1, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, p1, k1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 13: K1 (edge st), p1, *k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 15: K1 (edge st), k1, *p1, k5, p1, k3, p1, k1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 17: K1 (edge st), p1, *k5, p1, k5, p1; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 19: K1 (edge st), k1, *p1, k3, p1, k1, p1, k5; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 21: K1 (edge st), k1, *k1, [p1, k1] 4 times, k3; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Row 23: K1 (edge st), k1, *k2, [p1, k1] 4 times, k2; repeat from * two more times, k1 (edge st).
Repeat Rows 1-24 one more, then work Rows 1-2 once. Bind off knitwise.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
