





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Hygge Charm™: 2 balls 6334 Moonlight

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9]

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Double Seed Stitch pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use** any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Fringed Plant Mat

A simple knit mat in yarn with a bit of subtle shimmer helps protect furniture or highlight a table arrangement. Use this mat under your plants to help you remember to nurture them.

Finished measurements: 14" wide x 18" long [36 cm x 46 cm] excluding fringe.

PATTERN STITCH Double Seed Stitch

(worked over an odd number of stitches)

Row 1: *K1, p1*; repeat from * to *, end k1. Rows 2 and 3: *P1, k1*; repeat from * to *, end p1.

Row 4: Repeat Row 1. Repeat Rows 1-4 for Double Seed Stitch pattern.

MAT

Cast on 69 sts. Work in Double Seed Stitch pattern until Mat measures 18" [46 cm] from cast on edge. Bind off all sts.

FRINGE

Cut 138 - 6" [15 cm] pieces of yarn. Take one piece of varn and fold it in half. On cast-on edge of Mat, insert the crochet hook into the first stitch, hook the folded yarn loop and pull the loop through the stitch one third of the way. Slip the ends of yarn through the loop and pull tightly to secure. Continue in this manner across edge making a fringe in each stitch-69 fringe total. Repeat on opposite end (bound-off edge) of Mat.

Trim fringe to 21/4" [6 cm] or desired length.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

cm = centimeters; K = knit; P = purl; St st = stockinette stitch; Sts = stitches; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified: * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
