### What you will need:

RED HEART\* Super Saver\*: 1 skein each 316 Soft White A; 319 Cherry Red B; 312 Black C; 512 Turqua D; 321 Gold E; 334 Buff F

Susan Bates\* Knitting Needles: 6 mm [US 10]

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Susan Bates® Easy Wrap Pom Pon Maker

13 - Miniature Clothespins (available at craft chains), stitch holder, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.

# Santa's Wardrobe Garland

Santa's clothing serves as a happy reminder of who will be sliding down the chimney Christmas Eve! Knit each piece including, overalls, hat, jacket, socks, mittens, boots and his roomy bag.

**MEASUREMENTS:** Santa Wardrobe pieces vary in size from  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " [6 cm] to 8" [20 cm] long.

#### **SPECIAL STITCHES**

**KFB =** Knit in front and then in back of same stitch (increase).

**K2TOG =** Knit 2 sts together (decrease).



### **JACKET**

With A, cast on 18 sts.

Rows 1-5: Knit across row. At end of

Row 5, cut A.

Row 6 (Right Side): With B, K2tog, knit

across row, K2tog—16 sts.

Rows 7-19: Knit across row.

Row 20: K2tog, knit across row,

K2tog-14 sts.

Row 21: Knit across row.

Row 22: K2tog, knit across row,

K2tog-12 sts.

Row 23: Knit across row, at end of row,

cut B.

Row 24: With A, K2tog, knit across row,

K2tog-10 sts

Row 25: Knit across row.

Row 26: K2tog, knit across row,

K2tog-8 sts.

Row 27: Knit across row.

Row 28: K2tog, knit across row,

K2tog-6 sts.

Row 29: Knit across row. Row 30: Bind off all sts.

#### **Button Placket**

With A, cast on 3 sts.

Rows 1-17: Knit across row.

Row 18: Bind off all sts, leaving a 15" [38 cm] tail for sewing. Using photograph for placement, sew Button Placket to

front of Jacket.

## **BELT**

With C, cast on 16 sts.

Rows 1-4: Knit across row.

**Row 5:** Bind off all sts, leaving a 15" [38 cm] tail for sewing. Using photograph for placement, sew Belt to Jacket.

#### **BELT BUCKLE**

With **E** and Yarn Needle, using photograph for placement, embroider Buckle to Belt.

## SLEEVE (make 2)

With A. cast on 2 sts.

Rows 1-2: Knit across row. Row 3: Kfb, Kfb—4 sts.

Rows 4-5: Knit across row.

Row 6: Kfb, knit across row, Kfb-6 sts.

Cut A.

Rows 7-22 (Right Side): With B, knit across row. At end of Row 22, cut

Rows 23-28: With A, knit across row.
Row 29: Bind off all sts. With B and Yarn
Needle, seam the last 10 rows of Jacket
to first 10 rows of Sleeve. With A, seam

top of Sleeve to top of Jacket.



# **PANTS**

With **B**, cast on 16 sts. **Rows 1-18:** Knit across row.

#### First Leg

Row 19 (Right Side): Knit first 6 sts, K2tog, slip last 8 sts onto stitch holder—7 sts.

Rows 20-37: Knit across row. At end of Row 37, cut B.

Rows 38-43: With  ${\bf A}$ , knit across row.

Row 44: Bind off all sts.

### **Second Leg**

Slip sts from stitch holder back onto needle.

With **B**, and Right Side facing you, K2tog,

knit across row—7 sts. Repeat Rows 20-44 of First Leg.

## SUSPENDERS (make 2)

With C, cast on 34 sts.

Rows 1-3: Knit across row.

Row 4: Bind off all sts.

With **E** and Yarn Needle, using photograph for placement, tack

Suspenders to Pants.



# HAT

With A, cast on 14 sts.

Rows 1-6: Knit across row. At end of

Row 6, cut yarn.

**Row 7 (Right Side):** With **B**, K2tog, knit across row. k2tog—12 sts

Rows 8-11: Knit across row.

Repeat Rows 7-11 until there are 2 sts left on needle. Bind off all sts.



# MITTEN (make 2)

(1st Mitten)

With **A**, cast on 6 sts.

Rows 1-5: Knit across row. At end of

Row 5, cut yarn.

**Row 6 (Right Side):** With **B**, knit across row.

Row 7: Knit across row.

**Row 8:** Knit 6, cast on 2 sts at end of row—8 sts.

Rows 9-10: Knit across row.

**Row 11:** Bind off first 2 sts, knit across row—6sts.

Rows 12-16: Knit across row.

**Row 17:** K2tog, knit across row, K2tog—4sts.

Row 18: K2tog, k2tog—2sts.

Row 19: K2tog; fasten off.

(2nd Mitten)

With **A**, cast on 6 sts.

Repeat Rows 1-6 of 1st mitten.

Rows 7-8: Knit across row.

**Rows 9-20:** Repeat Rows 8-19 of 1st

mitten.

# BOOT (make 2) (1st Boot)

With A, cast on 7 sts.

Rows 1-5: Knit across row. At end of

Row 5, cut yarn.

Rows 6-9 (Right Side): With C, knit across row. At end of Row 9, cast on 4 sts.

Rows 10-16: Knit across row—11 sts.

Row 17: Bind off all sts.

(2nd Boot)

With A, cast on 7 sts.

Repeat Rows 1-9 of 1st Boot but DO NOT cast on 4 sts at end of Row 9—7 sts

**Row 10:** Knit across row, cast on 4 sts at end of row—11 sts.

Rows 11-18: Repeat Rows 10-17 of 1st Boot.

# SOCK (make 2)

With **D**, cast on 6 sts.

Rows 1-14: Knit across row.

Row 15: Kfb, knit across row, k2tog-6

sts

Row 16: Knit across row.

Rows 17-24: Repeat Rows 15-16, 4 times.

Row 25: K2tog, knit across row,

k2tog-4 sts.

**Row 26:** K2tog, k2tog—2 sts.

Row 27: K2tog; fasten off.

Heel

With **A** and Yarn Needle, using photograph for placement, embroider

Heel on Sock.



# BAG (make 2)

With **F**, cast on 16 sts.

Row 1: Knit across row.

Row 2: Kfb, knit across row, Kfb—18 sts.

Row 3: Knit across row.

Row 4: Kfb, knit across row, Kfb-20 sts.

Rows 5-40: Knit across row.

Row 41: [K2tog], repeat 9 more

times-10 sts.

Row 42: Knit across row.

Row 43: [Kfb], repeat 9 more times—20

sts.

Rows 44-51: Knit across row.

Row 52: Bind off all sts.

#### **Braid**

With **B**, cut 3 - 12" [30 cm] strands. Braid the 3 strands together with an overhand knot at each end. Tie around Row 42 of Bag. Use photograph for placement of Braid.

# **CLOTHESLINE**

With **F** and crochet hook, chain for 80" [203 cm], or desired length.

**Row 1:** Slip stitch in second chain from hook, and in each chain across; fasten off.

# **ASSEMBLY**

With **B** and Yarn Needle, using photograph for placement, tack Santa's Wardrobe to Clothesline. Attach mini clothespins over tacked areas.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in all ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Colors A, B, C; cm = centimeters; mm = millimeters; K = knit; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
