## Girlie Fashion Sweater Ornament

*Knit a sweater for the tree! This darling sweater has a girlie look and is a nice gift for a special gal. Great for attaching to gifts of food...or maybe a gift of yarn to a special knitting friend.*

### What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®, 1 skein each of 1701 Hot Pink A, 1502 Iced Aqua B, 1207 Cornsilk C, and 1803 Blue Hawaii D

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:  
4 mm [US 6]

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:  
3.75 mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle, one, 5/8" button,  
sewing needle and matching  
thread

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4" (10 cm); 24  
rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette  
Stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use  
any size needles to obtain the  
gauge

Sweater measures 4" (10 cm) long

### SWEATER ORNAMENT

#### Body

With A, cast on 80 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Row 2: Purl across.

Row 3: Knit across.

Row 4: K2 tog across: 40 sts.

Row 5: Knit across.

Row 6: Purl across.

Rows 7-16: Repeat Rows 5 and 6.

#### Right front

Row 1 (Right side): K 10, turn leaving  
remaining sts unworked.

Row 2: Purl across.

Rows 3-8: Repeat Rows 1 and 2.

Bind off all sts in knit.

#### Back

Row 1 (Right side): With right side facing, join  
A and knit across 20 sts for Back, turn leaving  
remaining sts unworked: 20 sts.

Row 2: Purl across.

Row 3: Knit across.

Row 4: Purl across.

Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

Bind off all sts in knit.

#### Left front

Row 1 (Right side): With right side facing, join  
A and knit across 10 sts for Left Front: 10 sts.

Row 2: Purl across.

Row 3: Knit across.

Row 4: Purl across.

Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

Bind off all sts in knit.

#### Sleeve (Make 2)

With B, cast on 12 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Rows 2 and 3: Knit across.

Row 4: Purl across.

Row 5: Knit across.

Row 6: Purl across.

Rows 7-12: Repeat Rows 5 and 6.

Bind off all sts in knit.

#### Flower

With C, cast on 16 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Row 2: K2 tog across: 8 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" (20.5 cm) end. Thread  
yarn needle with end and weave through  
remaining stitches. Draw up firmly; fasten  
securely.

#### Pocket

With D, cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Row 2: Purl across.

Rows 3-6: Repeat Rows 1 and 2.

Bind off all sts in knit.

### FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with a length of A. With  
right sides together and using photo as a  
guide, sew shoulder seams. Using crochet  
hook and with right side facing, join A with a  
slip st at cast on edge of Right Front. Work sc  
along edge of rows to bind off edge of Right  
Front, ch 3 (for buttonhole), work sc along  
neck opening and along Left Front edge of  
rows to cast on edge of Left Front, fasten off.  
Thread yarn needle with a length of B. With  
right sides together and using photo as a  
guide, sew Sleeves to sleeve openings and  
sew Sleeve seam.

Thread yarn needle with a length of D. With  
wrong side of Pocket together with right side  
of Left Front, and using photo as a guide, sew  
Pocket to Left Front.

Continued...

Thread yarn needle with a length of **C**. With wrong side of Flower together with right side of Right front, and using photo as a guide, sew Flower to Right Front.

Thread yarn needle with a length of **D**, using photo as a guide and using the chain stitch, embroider Flower leaves and stem.

Thread yarn needle with a length of **B**, and using photo as a guide, embroider a French knot in center of Flower.

Thread sewing needle with matching thread. Sew button to Left Front across from buttonhole on Right Front.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeter; K = knit; mm = millimeter;

P = purl; sc = single crochet(s); st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together.
