



KNIT SKILL LEVEL EASY

## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver:** 1 skein each 319 Cherry Red A, 376 Burgundy B, 624 Tea Leaf C, 389 Hunter Green D, 334 Buff E

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10]. Susan Bates®Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8] (for hanging loops and button loops)

Twenty-four 5/8" wooden buttons, sewing thread and needle, rope (for holding all pockets, optional), varn needle

**GAUGE:** 16 sts =  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (11 cm): 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.



**RED HEART® Super** Saver<sup>®</sup>, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m);

multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

# Each pocket measures 4½ (11 cm) x 4½" (11 cm) square. POCKET (make 24 – 6 each with A, B, C, and D) Cast on 16 sts.

### Back

Work in Garter st (knit every row) until piece measures about 41/2" (11 cm) from beginning.

#### Front

Work in Garter st for 6 rows. Work in Stockinette st (knit on Right side, purl on Wrong side) for 12 rows. Work in Garter st for 6 rows. Bind off.

## DUPLICATE STITCH NUMBERS

With E and following chart, work numbers in duplicate st over the Stockinette st section of pocket.

Note: The charts show the duplicate stitch number within the Stockinette stitch section of the pocket, 16 sts wide and 12 rows tall.

# FINISHING

Fold pocket in half, with Wrong side facing out and bringing cast-on edge up to meet bind-off edge. Sew side seams and turn pocket Right side out.

### Hanging Loop

(make 24 – 1 for each pocket) With crochet hook and **C**, leaving a long beginning tail, ch 24.

Row 1: Slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Fold piece in half to form a loop. Thread tails into yarn needle and sew ends of loop to upper left side seam of pocket.

### Button Loop

#### (make 24 – 1 for each pocket)

With crochet hook and **C**, leaving a long beginning tail, ch 8. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Fold piece in half to form a loop. Thread tails into yarn needle and sew to inside center back of pocket.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button to center front of pocket, opposite button loop. Work in any remaining ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS: A**, **B**, **C**, **D**,  $\mathbf{E} = \text{colors A}$ , **B**, **C**, D, E; ch = chain; st(s) = stitch(es).
