## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Irresistible™**: 4 balls 7110 Aran

**Susan Bates® Knitting**

**Needles**: 25mm [US 50]

Cable needle, yarn needle, 20" x 20" (51 x 51 cm) pillow form, 3-ALL in ONE dark brown large 4-hole sewing wood buttons with wide edge 2" (5 mm) , sewing needle and matching thread

**Optional**: Fabric to cover pillow form if it shows through pillow cover.

**GAUGE**: 4 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 5 rows = 4" [10 cm] in St st.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE**. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.

# Comfort Cable Pillow

Just looking at this big cushy pillow makes you feel more relaxed! It knits up easily with thick jumbo yarn, a big cable and button back opening.

**Pillow cover measures 20" x 20" (51 x 51 cm) after overlapping back ribbing.**

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**C1F (Cable 1 front)**: Slip 1 st to a cable needle, hold to front of work, knit next st off left needle, then knit the st off the cable needle.

**C1B (Cable 1 back)**: Slip 1 st to a cable needle, hold to back of work, knit next st off left needle, then knit the st off the cable needle.

## PILLOW COVER

Using the long-tail cast on method, cast on 18 sts.

**Row 1 (Right Side)**: \*K1, p1; repeat from \* across.

**Rows 2-3**: Continue to work in k1, p1 ribbing.

Change to St st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).

Work in St st until piece measures 10¾" (27 cm) from cast on, ending with a wrong side row.

## Cable Rows

**Row 1**: (Right Side) K6, p1, k4, p1, k6.

**Row 2**: (Wrong Side) P6, k1, p4, k1, p6.

**Row 3**: K6, p1, C1F, C1B, p1, k6.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until piece measures 30½" (77 cm) from cast on.

Change to St st.

Work in St st until piece measures 39½" (100 cm) from cast on.

Work k1, p1 ribbing for next 2 rows.

Bind off in k1, p1 ribbing.

## FINISHING

With right sides facing, overlap rib sections of back cover. With yarn needle, sew side seams of pillow, sewing through three layers of fabric when you reach the rib sections.

With yarn needle, weave in all loose ends.



Turn pillow right side out. With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to bottom rib section starting at one side and placing buttons 4½" (11 cm) apart.

Insert pillow form and button the cover, slipping buttons through top rib sts to close.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = stockinette stitch; **\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated



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
