MATERIALS

Red Heart® **Soft**® (5 oz/141 g; 256 yds/234 m)

Contrast A White (4600) 1 ball Contrast B Navy (4604) 1 ball Contrast C Wine (4608) 1 ball

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. 12" x 16" (30.5 x 40.5 cm) pillow form. Stitch markers. Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately Rep = Repeat**Cont** = Continue(ity) **RS** = Right side **St(s)** = Stitch(es) $\mathbf{K} = Knit$ $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}$ **WS** = Wrong side **Rem** = Remaining

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 12 x 16" [30.5 x 40.5 cm].

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS NOTES

· When working from chart, wind small balls of the colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate points. To change colors, twist the two yarns around each other where they meet on WS to avoid a hole.

PILLOW FRONT

With A, cast on 78 sts. Work 4 rows stocking st. Proceed in Chart as follows:

1st row: (RS), With A, K3, Knit 1st row of Chart, reading row from right to left to last 3 sts. With A, K3. 2nd row: With A, P3. Purl 2nd row of Chart, reading row from left to right to last 3 sts. With A, K3. Chart is now in position. Cont in chart to end of Chart.

With A, work 3 rows stocking st. Cast off

PILLOW BACK

With A, cast on 78 sts. Work in stocking st as follows: 1st to 4th rows: With A. 5th to 16th rows: With B. 17th to 19th rows: With A. 20th to 31st rows: With B. 32nd to 35th rows: With A. 36th to 45th rows: With C.

46th to 79th rows: Rep 1st to 34th rows once more. Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew Pillow Front to Back along 3 sides, matching C stripes.
Insert pillow form. Sew rem side closed.
