

## MATERIALS

Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Hygge $^{\text {TM }}$ (8 oz/227 g; 212 yds/194 m)
Contrast A Cloud (8339)
Contrast B Indigo (8381)
2 balls or $424 \mathrm{yds} / 388 \mathrm{~m}$
1 ball or $212 \mathrm{yds} / 194 \mathrm{~m}$
Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Hygge Fur ${ }^{\text {™ (7 oz/200 g; } 260 \text { yds/238 m) }}$
Contrast C Cotton Tail (0108) $\mathbf{1}$ ball
Sizes U.S. $101 / 2(6.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ and U.S. $13(9 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. 20 " $[51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] square pillow form. 5 " [12.5 $\mathrm{cm}]$ piece of cardboard.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 20 " $[51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] square.

## GAUGES

9 sts and 17 rows $=4$ " [10 cm ] with 2 strands Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Hygge ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ held tog and larger needle in garter stitch.
13 sts and 15 rows $=4 "$ $\left[10 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ] with 1 strand Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ $H_{y g g e}{ }^{T M}$ and smaller needle in stocking stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Front

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog and larger needle, cast on 44 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Work in garter stitch (knit every row) until work from beg measures 193/4" [ 50 cm ].
Cast off.

## Back

With 1 strand of A and smaller needle, cast on 64 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Beg on a knit row, work even in stocking st until piece from beg measures 193/4" [ 50 cm ].
Cast off.

## FINISHING

Sew 3 sides of Front and Back tog. Insert pillow form. Sew rem side closed.

Loopy Pompom (make 13): Wind C around $5^{\prime \prime}[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ piece of cardboard approx 10 times. Remove from cardboard and tie tightly in center.Do nottrim loops. Sew Loopy Pompoms securely to Pillow Front (as shown in diagram on page 2). Note: Pompoms will be floppy.
