





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 1 skein each: 1623 Mallard A, 1803 Blue Hawaii B, 1601 Lettuce C.

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6.0mm [US 10]

Yarn needle, Stitch marker

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4" (10 cm); 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Seed Stitch pattern, CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

7oz (198g), 370 vd (338m) and multicolor 5oz (141a), 230 vd (211m) skeins.





Dreidel Table Runner & Napkin Holders

Set a memorable table for Hanukkah celebrations! Knit napkin rings and runner insets are shaped like toy dreidels for a new spin on traditional holiday decor.

Table Runner measures: 14" wide x 53" long (35 cm x 137 cm)

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

SI 1 kwise = Slip 1 knitwise. Insert the right needle into the next stitch on the left needle as if you were knitting the stitch. Pull this stitch off the left needle. The stitch is now on the right needle and twisted.

K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together. Insert the right needle into two stitches at the same time and knit. This will result in a decrease of one stitch. This decrease will slant to the right. **Cable Cast On** = Insert right-hand needle between the first two stitches, wrap and bring yarn through. Transfer the newly created stitch onto the left hand needle.

P2SSO = Purl 2 stitches, pass slipped stitch over the knitted stitch.

PATTERN STITCHES

Seed Stitch (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from * across, end k1. Repeat Row 1 for Seed Stitch pattern.

TABLE RUNNER Section 1 (make 2)

With A. cast on 45 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): Work in Seed St. pattern for 29 rows.

Next Row: With B, work 18 rows in Seed St. pattern.

Next Row: With C, work 10 rows in Seed St. pattern.

Bind off all sts in Seed St. pattern.

Section 2 (make 2)

With C. cast on 45 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): Work in Seed St. pattern for 7 rows.

Next Row: With B. work 10 rows in Seed St. pattern.

Next Row: With A. work 28 rows in Seed St. pattern.

Next Row: With B. work 18 rows in Seed St. pattern.

Next Row: With C, work 10 rows in Seed St. pattern.

Bind off all sts in Seed St. pattern.

DREIDEL

For Table Runner: Make 6 in B and 2 in A. For Napkin Holders: Make 2 each in A. B. and C.

Leave 8" (20 cm) tails at cast-on and bind-off to aid in sewing.

I-Cord Handle

Cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: K3, do not turn. Slip the 3 sts on the right-hand needle back to the left-hand needle.

Row 2: K3, pulling yarn gently across back of work. No not turn. Slip the 3 sts on right-hand needle back to left-hand needle.

Row 3: K3, do not slip sts to left-hand needle. Turn.

Row 4: Cable cast on 4 sts. then k7. Turn.

Row 5: Cable cast on 4 sts, then k10, p1. Mark this side as the right side of work. Turn.

Body of Dreidel

Row 6: Slip 1 knitwise, k9, purl the last st.

Rows 7-16: Repeat Row 6.

Piece measures 2" (5 cm) from cast-on edge.

Shape Top

Row 17 (Right Side): SI 1 knitwise, k3, slip 2 together as if working k2tog, k1, p2sso, k3, p1.

Row 18: Slip 1 knitwise, k3, p1, k3, p1.

Row 19: Slip 1 knitwise, k2, slip 2 together as if working k2tog, k1, p2sso, k2, p1.

Row 20: Slip 1 knitwise, k2, p1, k2, p1.

Row 21: Slip 1 knitwise, k1, slip 2 together as if working k2tog, k1, p2sso, k1, p1.

Row 22: Slip 1 knitwise, [k1, p1] twice. Row 23: Slip 1 knitwise, slip 2 together as if

working k2tog, k1, p2sso, p1.

Row 24: P3tog. Cut yarn. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Using schematic as a guide, align sections 1 and 2 as indicated on a flat surface. Sew dreidels to sections 1 and 2 to form runner. Weave in ends.

NAPKIN HOLDERS

Make 3, sewing **A/B**, **B/C** and **C/A** as follows: Using yarn tails, sew 1" (2.5 cm) down on either side from top of dreidel.

At lower edge, thread yarn tail through yarn needle and pull yarn through back of I-cord to cast-on edge. Tack on either side of I-cord, then tack outer edges of dreidel.

TIPS & HINTS

Join a new ball of yarn when there are approximately 6" (15 cm) of yarn left from the old ball, also leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail of yarn with the joined yarn. Weave these ends in neatly on the wrong side of the fabric in a zig-zag pattern for a few inches, and then trim off excess.

BO = bind off; **K** = knit; mm = millimeters; **P** = purl; [] or * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
