MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Contrast A Aran (0313)1 ballContrast B Oatmeal (0326)1 ballContrast C Burgundy (0376)1 ballContrast D Gold (0321)1 ball

Note: 1 ball of A and B will make 6 Tea Cozies

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume™ knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® Steel Yarn Needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together **P** = Purl

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches

together

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Ssk = Slip next 2 sttiches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es) **WS** = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

SIZE

One size, to fit 6 cup tea pot.

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch

INSTRUCTIONS

Front and Back (Make alike)

HOUSE

With A, cast on 36 sts.
Knit 3 rows (garter st), noting 1st

row is WS.

1st row: (RS). Knit. 2nd row: Purl.

Cont in stocking st until work from beg measures 4" [10 cm], ending on a WS row.

Leave sts on a spare needle.

Roof

With B, cast on 40 sts. Work 4 rows stocking st.

Picot row: *K2tog. yo. Rep from *

last 2 sts. K2.
Next row: Purl.
Next row: Knit.
Next row: Purl.



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Lay Cozy flat, seam top of Roof

Sew Window and Door to front of

Sew seams 31/4" [8.5 cm] from top

and bottom edges on either side

for spout and handle openings.

FINISHING

Cozy.

using long tail.

Picot edge: With RS facing, fold work to align cast on edge with sts on needle. *Pick up st from cast on edge and place on left-hand needle. K2tog with next st on needle. Rep from * to end of row. **Next row:** *P8. P2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 36 sts.

Join House to Roof: With RS of both pieces facing, place spare needle holding House sts behind current working needle with Roof sts, making sure to align sts. *K2tog taking 1 st from House and 1 st from Roof. Rep from * to end of row. 36 sts.

Proceed as follows: **1st row:** (WS). Purl.

2nd row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts.

K2tog. K1. 34 sts. **3rd row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 7 times more.

20 sts.

Next row: (RS). (ssk) 5 times.

(K2tog) 5 times. 10 sts.

Cast off purlwise. Break yarn

leaving a long tail.

Door

With C, cast on 8 sts.


1st row: (RS). K1. P2. K2. P2. K1.


2nd row: K1. K2. P2. K3. **3rd row:** As 2nd row. **4th row:** As 1st row.

Rep last 4 rows once more and then 1st and 2nd rows once more.

Cast off in pat.

With D, embroider doorknob with a French knot.





FRENCH KNOT

Window

With B, cast on 11 sts. Knit 2 rows. Break B. Join D.

Next row: (RS). Knit.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Break D. Join B.

Next row: With B, knit. Cast off knitwise (WS).

With B, duplicate st up center st and center row and either side of piece.
