





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Fur™: 1 ball 9100 Polar A

RED HEART* Super Saver*: 1 skein each 319 Cherry Red B and 512 Turqua C

Susan Bates* Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] and 6.5mm [US 10½]

Yarn needle, sewing needle, white thread, 1" (25mm) white button

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stripe Pattern with smaller needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.



RED HEART* FurTM, Art. E831 available in 3.5 oz (100 g) 11 yd (10 m) balls



RED HEART* Super Saver*, Art. E300 available in solid color 7

oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); prints, multicolor and heather 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Stylish Pet Scarf

All the most fashionable pets this winter season are wearing fur! This buttoned scarf trimmed in lush Fur yarn is picture-perfect for holiday family photos. Pattern is written in four sizes to fit dogs and cats alike.

Directions are for size X-small. Changes for sizes Small, Medium and Large are in parentheses. Dog in photo is wearing size Small.

Scarf measures: 3 (4, 5, 6)" [8 (10, 13, 15) cm] wide and 19 (23½, 28½, 33½)" [48 (60, 72, 85) cm] long

To fit dog neck measurement: 11 (13½, 16½, 19½)" [28 (34, 42, 50) cm]

NOTE

When working Stripe Pattern, carry yarn not in use along edge of work. Twist unused yarn at the beginning of every Right Side row.

STRIPE PATTERN

Row 1 (Wrong Side): With B, purl across.

Row 2 (Right Side): Knit across.

Row 3: Purl across. Row 4: Knit across.

Rows 5-8: Change to C. Purl across.

SCARF

With **A** and larger needles, cast on 6 (8, 10, 12) sts.

Row 1: Knit across.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail to weave in later

Row 2: Change to **B** and smaller needles. Knit into the front and back of each st—12 (16, 20, 24) sts.
Repeat Stripe Pattern Rows 1-8 until piece measures 3 (4, 5, 6)" [8 (10, 13, 15) cm] from Row 2.

Buttonhole

Buttonhole row: Working in Stripe Pattern, work 6 (8, 10, 12) sts, yo, K2tog, work Stripe Pattern to end of row. Work Stripe Pattern for an additional 14 (17½, 21½, 25½)" [36 (44, 55, 65) cm] from buttonhole.

Cut **B** and **C**, leaving long tails for weaving in later.

Next row: With **A** and larger needles, *K2tog; repeat from * across row—6 (8, 10, 12) sts. Bind off.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in all loose ends.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button on scarf end opposite from buttonhole.

ABBREVIATIONS

A = Color A; B = Color B; C = Color C; K = knit; mm = millimeters; K2tog = Knit the next 2 sts together; P = Purl; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over needle; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
