Green Light Hat

Whether in town or spending time in the country, a man needs to stay warm and here's the perfect hat to cater to his needs. Knit it in one piece with super bulky yarn that helps speed up the knitting process.

To Fit Head Circumference: 20".

RED HEART® "Light & Lofty®": 1 skein 9931 Rainforest Multi.

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 1 skein 303 Painted Desert Print.

Circular Knitting Needles: 12.75 [US 17] 24" long. Place marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 7 sts = 4"; 12 rows = 4" in St st with 1 strand of each yarn held tog. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size** needle to obtain the gauge.

Special Abbreviation

M1 (make one stitch) = Lift running thread before next stitch onto left needle and knit into the back loop.

HAT

With 1 strand of each yarn held together, cast on 36 sts. **Row 1:** * P2, k2; repeat from * to end of row. Repeat Row 1 once more.

Join

Place marker for beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist sts. Work 3 rounds in P2, k2 rib as established.

Next Round (Inc): * K9, m1; repeat from * around–40 sts. Work even in St st (knit every round) until piece measures 7" from beginning. Cut Super Saver and continue in Light and Lofty only. Work even until piece measures 9" from beginning.

Shape Crown

Round 1: [K8, k2tog] 4 times–36 sts. Round 2: [K7, k2tog] 4 times–32 sts. Round 3: [K6, k2tog] 4 times–28 sts. Round 4: [K5, k2tog] 4 times–24 sts. Round 5: [K2tog] 12 times–12 sts.

FINISHING

Cut yarn leaving long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to secure. Sew 2 rows at lower edge together. Weave in yarn ends.

Abbreviations: K = knit; **mm** = millimeters; p = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; **tog** = together; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
