MAKE THIS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED



YARN

- **Red Heart® With Love®**
(7 oz/198 g; 370 yds/338 m)

COLORS

Quantity

- **Tangerine (1220)**
1 ball or 275 yds/250 m

TOOLS

- Size U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

GAUGE

16 sts and 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =	Rem = Remaining
Approximately	Rep = Repeat
Beg = Beginning	RS = Right side
K = Knit	St(s) = Stitch(es)

INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

NOTES

- Scarf is made by repeatedly knitting 4 rows followed by a wrap row and a drop row.
- In a wrap row, yarn is wrapped around right-hand needle twice between knit stitches.
- In a drop row, wraps from the previous wrapping row are dropped off needle as you work knit stitches.
- To wrap yarn around needle twice, carry yarn from front to back over top of right-hand needle then wrap it under right-hand needle to bring it back to front (first wrap completed). Carry yarn from front to back over top of right-hand needle again (second wrap completed). Leave yarn at back of work so that you are ready to knit next stitch.
- When you finish row, lightly pull down on the Scarf. This will open and straighten wrapped loops that were dropped off needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (Approx) 7" x 60" [18 x 151 cm].





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INSTRUCTIONS

SCARF

Make a slip knot and place it on one needle.
Slip knot counts as first stitch.



Slip knot

Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.

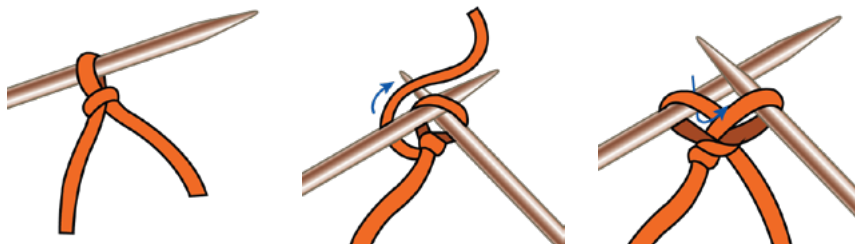
With tip of needle, pull working yarn through the pretzel to create loop and pull yarn to tighten.

Cast on 26 stitches (sts).

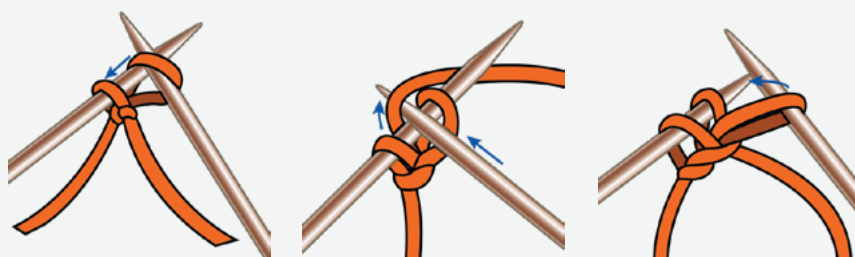
Cast On

Start with slip knot on left-hand needle.

Insert right-hand needle through loop as with knit stitch (yarn at back, from the bottom up).



Start knit stitch, then transfer loop from right-hand needle back onto left - 2 stitches on needle.



Continue (cont) casting on in this same manner until there are 26 sts on needle.





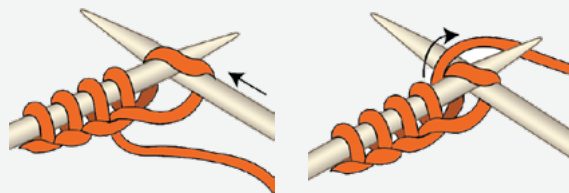

INSTRUCTIONS

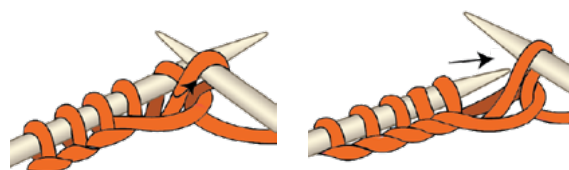
1st to 4th rows: Knit all stitches (sts).

Knit 1 (K1)

Insert right-hand needle from **left to **right** through front of next stitch on left-hand needle. Wrap working yarn counter-clockwise around **right**-hand needle.*



Pull through a loop, dropping stitch from left-hand needle - 1 stitch knit.



Repeat (rep) from * until all 26 stitches (sts) will be knit.



Wrap & Drop

5th row: (Wrap row). K1. *Wrap yarn around right-hand needle twice. K1. Repeat (Rep) from * to end of row.



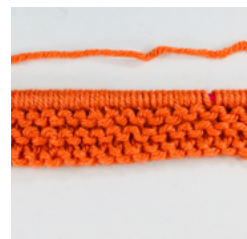

6th row: (Drop row). K1.
*Drop next 2 wraps off of
left-hand needle. K1. Rep
from * to end of row.



drop wraps



drop row complete

7th to 10th rows: Knit all sts.

Rep last 6 rows (5th to 10th rows) until work from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 59½" [152 cm], ending with working 4 knit rows.

Cast off

Step 1: Knit first 2 sts loosely.

Step 2: Lift 2nd stitch from the point of right-hand needle over 1st stitch and drop it off needle (first stitch has been cast off).

Step 3: Knit next st.

Step 4: Lift 2nd stitch from the point of right-hand needle over 1st stitch and drop it off needle (next stitch has been cast off).

ABBREVIATIONS

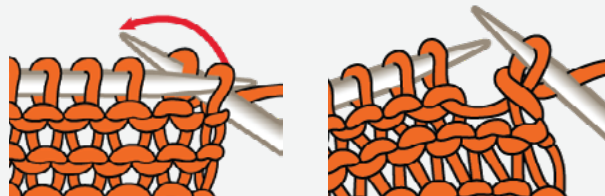
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INSTRUCTIONS

Rep Steps 3 and 4 until all stitches have been knit off left-hand needle and there is only 1 stitch remaining (rem) on *right*-hand needle. Cut yarn leaving 6" [15 cm] end and pull end through last stitch.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Pin Scarf to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.
