What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Sashay Sparkle™, 1 ball of 1012 Noir

Materials:

2 Yarn needles
46 Assorted large hole beads
4 Floating ring style beads
20 Assorted washer style beads
White all-purpose glue

Finished belt is 3 yds (2.7 m) long

Note: Materials list includes number of beads used for the long belt photographed. You may use a different number or type of beads as desired.



Beaded Necklace or Belt

Using Sashay as the base for a necklace is ingenious! It's great fun to choose your beads and washer-style beads and create this unique belt. Nice thing is...it can also be a belt.

NECKLACE

1. Cut 2 lengths of yarn each 3½ yds long.
2. Holding 2 lengths together, thread a large hole bead onto center of lengths.
3. Thread one length into washer style bead; then turn washer over and thread other end through same washer bead from the other side; place washer 1½" (3.8 cm) from first bead.
4. Thread both yarn ends through a large hole bead.

Tip: When threading the second length of Sashay through the bead pull the first to the side so you don't catch the loops of the yarn in the second needle.

5. Using photo as a guide, continue this sequence (bead, washer, bead) working out from center toward each end. Place your beads in a random order and thread each end through opposite sides of washers. Floating rings can be added between other beads, as desired.
6. End with a large hole bead at each end and knot to secure; then dab with glue. When glue is dry, trim ends about 1½" (3.8 cm) from knot.
