What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Sashay
Sparkle™: 1 ball of 1726 Salmon

Materials:

Yarn needle
14 Assorted large hole beads
4 Floating ring style beads
Jewelry clasp
Large jump ring
White all-purpose glue

Wrapped Bracelet or Necklace

Using Sashay instead of a chain puts a new twist on the usual wrapped bracelet. And as a bonus, you can wear it as a necklace when the spirit moves you!

BRACELET

1. Cut a length of yarn that measures 30" (76 cm) and thread it onto yarn needle.
2. Using photo as a guide, thread alternating beads and floating ring-style beads onto yarn.
3. Once last bead has been threaded onto yarn, thread yarn with jump ring. Remove yarn needle and knot to secure; dab knot with glue.
4. Slide clasp onto opposite yarn end and knot to secure; dab knot with glue.
5. When glue is dry, trim ends.
