What you will need:

RED HEART® Sizzle™: 1 spool
Color of choice

Susan Bates® Steel Crochet hook:
1.75 mm [US 6]

Scissors, tape measure, 13 Pony
Beads in one color and 6 in
another, complimenting color, all
beads are ½" [9 mm]

GAUGE is not important for this
project

RED HEART® Sizzle™, Art 146
available in 100 g (3.5 oz), 91 m
(100 yd) tubes



BRACELET

Photo 1 = Collect all materials for this project.

Photo 2 = Cut 6 strands of the thread, each
3 m [10'] long.

Photo 3 = Using all 6 strands held together,
make 4 knots in a row in the middle of the
pieces.

Photo 4 = Fold the strands in half – 2 knots sit
on one side and 2 knots sit on the other side
of the middle. Continue to work with all 12
ends and make 1 knot immediately under the
4 knots, forming a loop.

Photo 5 = Slip a bead onto crochet hook,
next slide crochet hook under all strands of
thread, fold strands over hook and pinch them
tight immediately underneath, slip bead over
strands and off hook.

Photo 6 = Slide bead over strands to loop and
knot at opposite end, make a knot after it. The
bead is now sitting between 2 knots.

Photo 7 = Repeat step 5.

Photo 8 = Slide bead over strands to knot at
opposite end, make a knot after it. The bead is
now sitting between 2 knots.

Repeat steps 5 and 6, always alternate adding
1 bead and 1 knot across the length of the
strands.

Photo 9 = At the end, make 1 knot over 1 bead.

Photo 10 = Make 1 knot behind the last bead
to secure the strands.

Photo 11 = Cut all strands.

Photo 12 = Wear immediately!
