What you will need:

RED HEART® Sizzle: 1 spool each of 8700 Bright Pink, 8251 Citron and 8269 Neon Orange

Yarn Needle, Deck of cards or something of similar size to wrap yarn around for the tassel.

RED HEART® Sizzle™, 100% Nylon Thread, Art. 146 available in 100 yd (91 m) spools



Tassel Necklaces

Here's a fun idea for making a necklace! Use bright colors of Sizzle and create one or more tassel necklaces. Great for accessorizing your look in a bright new way!

Tassel

Hold a deck of cards and wrap first color around it from bottom to top and back to the bottom again, 30 times. Cut yarn. (Photo 1)

Necklace

Cut a 24" (61 cm) length of 2nd color, or as long as you want your necklace to be plus a few inches. Thread the length of 2nd color onto a yarn needle, and then thread the needle between the top of the deck of cards and the wraps of first color, pull it halfway through. Tie it tight around the wraps to hold them all in place. You may need adult help to get the knot tight. (Photos 2 & 3)

Slide the wrap off the deck of cards and cut a 24" (61 cm) length of 3rd color. Wrap the length around the tassel about 1/2" (1.3 cm) below tied end. Wrap several times and then tie the 2 ends tightly together. Thread the ends onto a yarn needle. Thread the needle over top of the wrap you just made, and down through the middle of the tassel to hide the knot. If you tied your wrap very tight you might need adult help for this step. Cut ends of tassel and trim even. (Photos 4 & 5)

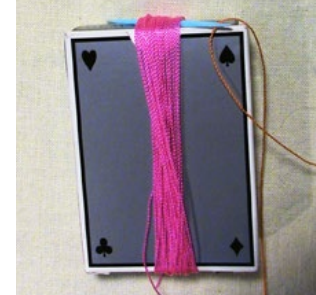

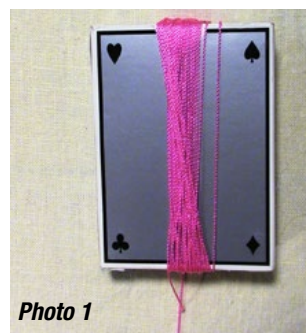
