What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft Essentials™: 2 balls 7530 Sugar Plum

RED HEART® Soft Essentials™, Art E856 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g) 131 yd (120 m) balls



Macramé Mesh Scarf

Love yarn, but don't knit or crochet? This scarf is made with the simplest macramé overhand knot using your hands as the only tools (no needles or hooks are needed).

Scarf: 15" x 80" (38 cm x 203 cm)

Note

The scarf is made with 3 strands of yarn held together throughout.

SCARF

Cut 42 strands of yarn each 5 yards long.

Step 1: Holding 3 strands of yarn together, make a butterfly bobbin. Wind yarn around your fingers in a figure 8 pattern, being sure to keep starting ends free.



Step 2: Carefully remove butterfly from finger and wind ending tail around center, then tuck the ends under the wrap. Work by pulling the starting ends to release yarn from butterfly bobbin. Repeat with remaining strands of yarn, making a total of 14 butterfly bobbins.



Step 3: Using 2 bobbins, tie yarn together with an overhand knot 10" from starting ends.



Step 4: Use an overhand knot to tie a new bobbin to the strands of the left-hand bobbin about 3" away from the first knot, leaving 10" ends from new bobbin as fringe. Repeat, tying another new bobbin to the left-hand strands.



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Step 5: Tie another new bobbin to each side of the scarf, leaving 10" ends for fringe and placing knots 3" away from previous knots. Tie center 2 groups together.



Step 6: Continue to add new bobbins to each side of scarf, tying pairs together between sides to form a mesh pattern, until all bobbins have been added.

Step 7: Leaving the outermost groups free, tie the remaining pairs together placing knots 3" from previous knots. 6 knots made.

Step 8: Tie each pair together, placing knots 3" from previous knots. 7 knots made.

Repeat Steps 7 and 8 five more times.



Step 9: Repeat Step 7 once more. Set the far right and far left bobbins aside. 6 knots made.

Step 10: Repeat Step 7 six more times, setting aside the far right and far left bobbin in each row, and tying one fewer knot in each row.



Step 11: Trim all ends to 6" long to finish fringe.
