What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft Baby Steps®: 1 ball 9939 Tickle

KB Knitting Loom: Sock Loom 2

Notions: knitting tool, tapestry needle, two US 5 (3.75 mm) double pointed needles to work the Kitchener stitch.

Gauge: 11 sts x 13 rows= 2 inches (5 cm) CHECK YOUR GAUGE

SIZE: Pattern is written for size 7.5 women. To make larger or smaller, work the sole of the foot until it measures 1.5 inches (3.8 cm) shorter than desired length.



Shorty Socks

Loom knit a pair of ankle socks and keep your feet looking cute! Multi-color yarn makes an interesting pattern and the smooth acrylic feels good and is easy to machine wash and dry.

SHOP KIT

Special Stitch

W&T= Wrap & Turn. Pick up stitch from the peg, with working yarn, ewrap peg, and place stitch being held back on the peg. Continue knitting now in the opposite direction.

ewrap: Wrap yarn around peg.

LEG

Cast on 36 sts, join to work in the round. http://www.knittingboard.com/ewrap-cast-on-page/

Round 1-Round 8: *K2p2; repeat from * to end of Round.

Round 9 and 10: *K2, p2; repeat from * to end.

Round 11 and 12: *K1, p2, k1; repeat from * to end.

Round 13 and Round 14: *P2, k2; repeat from * to end.

Round 15 and Round 16: *P1, k2, p1; repeat from * to end.

HEEL

The Heel is worked in short rows. A short-row is a row that is not worked all the way to the end, but rather to a certain point within the row. The sock is then turned and worked in the opposite direction.

Round 1: Knit from peg 1 to 19, W&T peg 20. **Round 2:** Knit from peg 19 to peg 1, W&T peg 1.

Round 3: Knit from peg 2 to peg 18, W&T peg 19.

Round 4: Knit from peg 18 to peg 3, W&T peg 2.

Round 5: Knit from peg 3 to peg 17, W&T peg 18.

Round 6: Knit from peg 17 to peg 4, W&T peg 3.

Round 7: Knit from peg 4 to peg 16, W&T peg 17.

Round 8: Knit from peg 16 to peg 5, W&T peg 4.

Round 9: Knit from peg 5 to peg 15, W&T per 16.

Round 10: Knit from peg 15 to peg 6, W&T peg 5.

Round 11: Knit from peg 6 to peg 14, W&T peg 15.

Round 12: Knit from peg 14 to peg 7, W&T peg 6.

Round 13: Knit from peg 7 to peg 15 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 16 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 14: Knit from peg 15 to peg 6 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 5 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 15: Knit from peg 6 to peg 16 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 17 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 16: Knit from peg 16 to peg 5 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 4 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 17: Knit from peg 5 to peg 17 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 18 (two raps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 18: Knit from peg 17 to peg 4 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 3 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 19: Knit from peg 4 to peg 18 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 19 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 20: Knit from peg 18 to peg 3 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 2 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Continued...





Round 21: Knit from peg 3 to peg 19 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 20 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 22: Knit from peg 19 to peg 2 (knitting the wraps and the stitch together). W&T peg 1 (two wraps and stitch on the peg).

End of heel instructions. You will have wraps on pegs 1 and peg 20. In the first round of the next section, work the stitches as instructed in the pattern and treat the wraps and the stitch as one.

FOOT

Worked in the round.

Next 2 Rounds: k20, *k2, p2; repeat from * to end.

Next 2 Rounds: k20, *k1, p2, k1; repeat from * to end.

Next 2 Rounds: k20, *p2, k2; repeat from * to end.

Next 2 Rounds: k20, *p1, k2, p1; repeat from * to end.

Repeat last 8 Rounds: until foot measures 1.5 inches (3.8 cm) shorter than desired length.

TOE

The toe is worked in short rows. The toe is worked over 18 pegs, from peg 2 to peg 19.

Round 1: Knit from peg 1 to 17. W&T peg 18.

Round 2: Knit from peg 17 to 2. W&T peg 1.

Round 3: Knit from peg 2 to 16. W&T peg 17.

Round 4: Knit from peg 16 to 3. W&T peg 2.

Round 5: Knit from peg 3 to 15. W&T peg 16.

Round 6: Knit from peg 15 to 4. W&T peg 3.

Round 7: Knit from peg 4 to 14. W&T peg 15.

Round 8: Knit from peg 14 to 5. W&T peg 4.

Round 9: Knit from peg 5 to 13. W&T peg 14.

Round 10: Knit from peg 13 to 6. W&T peg 5.

Round 11: Knit from peg 6 to 14 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 15 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 12: Knit from peg 14 to 5. W&T peg 4(two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 13: Knit from peg 5 to peg 15 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 16 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 14: Knit from peg 15 to peg 4 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 3 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 15: Knit from peg 4 to peg 16 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 17 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 16: Knit from peg 16 to peg 3 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 2 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 17: Knit from peg 3 to peg 17 (knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 18 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 18: Knit from peg 17 to peg 2(knitting the wrap and the stitch together). W&T peg 1 (two wraps and a stitch on the peg).

Round 19: Knit from peg 2 to peg 18(knitting the wrap and the stitch together).

Round 20: Knit from peg 17 to peg 1(knitting the wrap and the stitch together).

Close the toe with the Kitchener Stitch.

KITCHENER INSTRUCTIONS


Prepare (2) knitting needles, size 5: Place stitches 1-18 on one needle, and 19-36 on second needle. Hold the needles parallel with the tips pointing in the same direction, wrong sides (purl side) facing each other.




Caution: Be sure that the stitches are set up on the needles correctly.

Set up for kitchener stitch

Insert the tapestry needle into the first stitch on the needle closest to you as if to purl (from right to left), pull it through, leave the stitch on the needle.



Insert the needle into the first stitch on the back needle as if to knit (from left to right), leave the stitch on the needle. Pull the yarn through.



Needles are set up for the kitchener stitch, now follow the next 4 steps.

1. Insert the needle into the first stitch on the front needle as if to knit. Slip stitch off the needle.



- 2. Insert the needle into the next stitch on the front needle as if to purl. Leave stitch on the needle. Gently pull on the working yarn to snug up the stitch. Do not pull too much.
- 3. Insert the needle into the first stitch on the back needle as if to purl, and slip it off the needle.
- 4. Insert the needle into the next stitch on the back needle as if to knit. Leave this stitch on the needle. Snug up the yarn by pulling gently on the working yarn.

Repeat steps 1-4. At the end, the needles will have 2 stitches remaining. Proceed to step 1 and then to step 3.

Weave in the ends to the wrong side of the sock.

k=knit stitch **p**=purl stitch **st(s)**=stitch(es)
