## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Soft Baby**  
**Steps®:** 1 ball each 9630 Lime  
**A** and 9939 Tickle **B**

Scissors, measuring tape  
or ruler, 3" [8 cm] diameter  
Natural Beeswax Maple  
Wooden Ring, 5" (12 cm)  
x 7½" (19 cm) cardboard  
template, 2 large wooden  
buttons, 2 wooden miniature  
pots, crochet hook, yarn  
needle

# Lay & Play Baby Toys

Keep baby entertained with these brightly colored toys. Each one is quick to make, so you can easily create new toys for baby to play with.

## O RING TOY

**Step 1:** Holding one strand each of **A** and **B** together, wrap yarn around the widest part of the cardboard template 10 times. Cut yarn.

**Step 2:** With strands still folded in half, hold strands together at the center. Place strands under the **O** ring, then pull the ends of the yarn through the top loop to create fringe around the ring.

**Step 3:** Cut a 6" (15 cm) length of **A**. Knot it around the top of the ring to make a loop.

## TASSEL TOY

**Step 1:** Holding one strand each of **A** and **B** together, wrap yarn around the widest part of the cardboard template 15 times. For top of tassel, thread a 6" (15 cm) length of **A** under the top of the wraps and tie into a tight knot close to the wraps. Tie another knot at the top of the yarn to create a loop. Slip wraps off cardboard.

**Step 2:** To create tassel neck, tie a 7" (18 cm) length of **A** around wraps about 1" (2.5 cm) from top. Wrap ends of tie around wraps several times, then draw ends to inside of tassel. Cut the lower ends of the wraps and trim to make even.

## BUTTONS TOY

**Step 1:** To make a hanging loop, thread a 6" (15 cm) length of **A** through two of the buttonholes in the top button. Knot to secure.

**Step 2:** With **A** and crochet hook, crochet 2 chains that each measure about 6" (15 cm) long. Thread ends of chains through two buttonholes of both the top and bottom button; knot to secure.

**Step 3:** Cut 10 strands of each **A** and **B** that measure 10" (25.5 cm) long. Thread yarn strands through bottom buttonholes so that strands are folded in half. Tie a knot around the strands to secure them.

## WOODEN POTS TOY

**Step 1:** Cut 5 strands each of **A** and **B** that measure 14" (35.5 cm) long. Holding all strands together, tie a knot about 3" (7.5 cm) from the yarn tail.

**Step 2:** Still holding all strands together, thread strands through bottom of first pot so that the pot bottom rests on the knot. Tie a second knot near the top of the pot to secure it. Tie a third knot about 2½" (6.5 cm) up from the previous knot.

**Step 3:** With the pot opening facing down, thread the second mini pot onto the yarn strands. Secure second pot with a fourth knot about 1½" from the bottom of the pot.

**Step 4:** Using yarn needle, thread a 6" (15 cm) length of **A** through the center of the fourth knot. Knot loop to secure.
