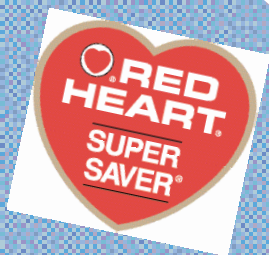

pom pom book mark

Beginner

RED HEART® "Super Saver®",
Art. E300 (7 oz/364 yard solid color
skeins and 5 oz/244 yard multi color
skeins)

Colors used: 994 Banana Berry Print,
929 Bikini, 972 Pink Camo and 932
Zebra

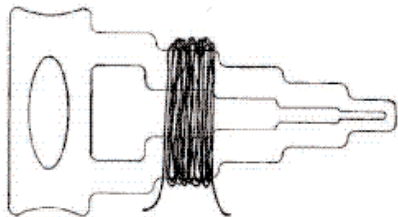
Amount needed: 7 yards of any color
will make four pom poms and a chain.

Crochet hook: 5.0 mm (US H-8)

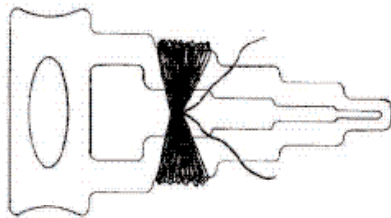
Additional tools: Susan Bates Plastic
Yarn needle, Mini Pom Pom Tool and
scissors.

Three Easy Steps to make a Pom Pom

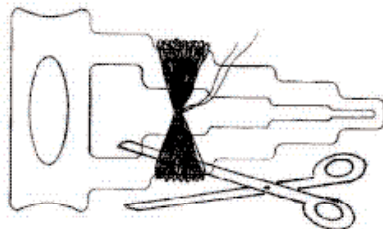
1. Wind the yarn around the pom pom
tool at the selected size on the tool, 30
times.



2. Cut a 12" length of yarn and tie
around the center of the wraps through
the opening in the center of the tool.



3. Cut loops on both sides by slipping
scissors through the loops to cut. Pull the
finished pom pom away from the tool,
fluff and trim, shaping into a round ball.



To make a bookmark: With crochet
hook, make a slip knot on the hook, leav-
ing a 4" tail. Chain 35 stitches. Fasten
off, leaving a 4" tail. Attach two pom-
poms at each end and knot securely.
Now you have completed your book
mark.

Other ideas: Hair tie for ponytail, head-
band, wrist band and shoe laces (you may
need to make a longer chain for some of
these projects).
