1562 Jadeite, and 1907
Boysenberry

Finger Knit Headband

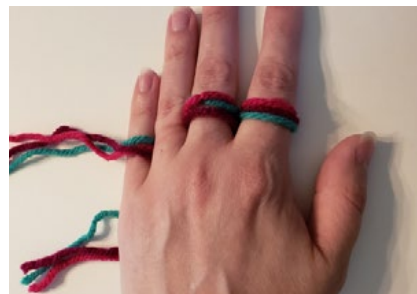
Finger knitting is a great way to introduce people of all ages to yarn crafting! This headband is quick to make and fun to customize with favorite colors.

HEADBAND

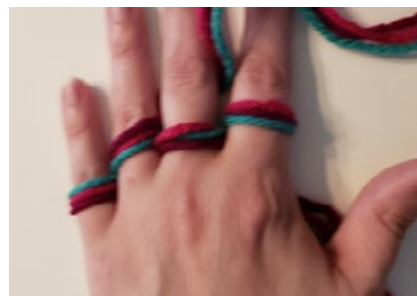
1. Using all three colors, tie slip knot and put it onto index finger of left hand



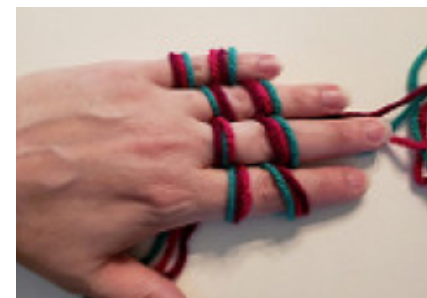
2. Weave yarn over and under the rest of the fingers of the hand.



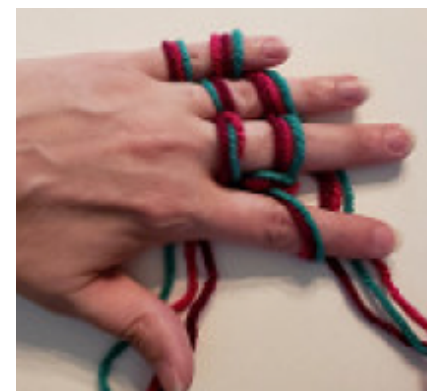
3. When you get to the pinkie, loop all the way around and finish creating the first row of loops.



4. When you return to the index finger, loop all the way around and work out to the pinkie again.
5. Bring the yarn back to the index finger. You should have 2 rows of yarn loops on the left hand.



6. Bring the back loops over the second row of loops and off of the fingers.

7. Repeat Steps 4-6 until piece is desired length. After repeating a few times the knitting pattern will build beneath your hand.
8. To bind off, pull tail through stitches and tie a knot. Leave long tails to use as ties for headband.
