## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver**  
1 skein: 4971 Retro Stripe

- Unicorn template
- Scissors
- Thick white paper stock
- Pencil
- Measuring tape or ruler
- Quart size plastic bag
- Craft glue

# Unicorn Mane Paper Craft

This unicorn craft combines paper and yarn. It would make a great party activity! You can also color it with markers for an even more colorful time.

## UNICORN

### Steps

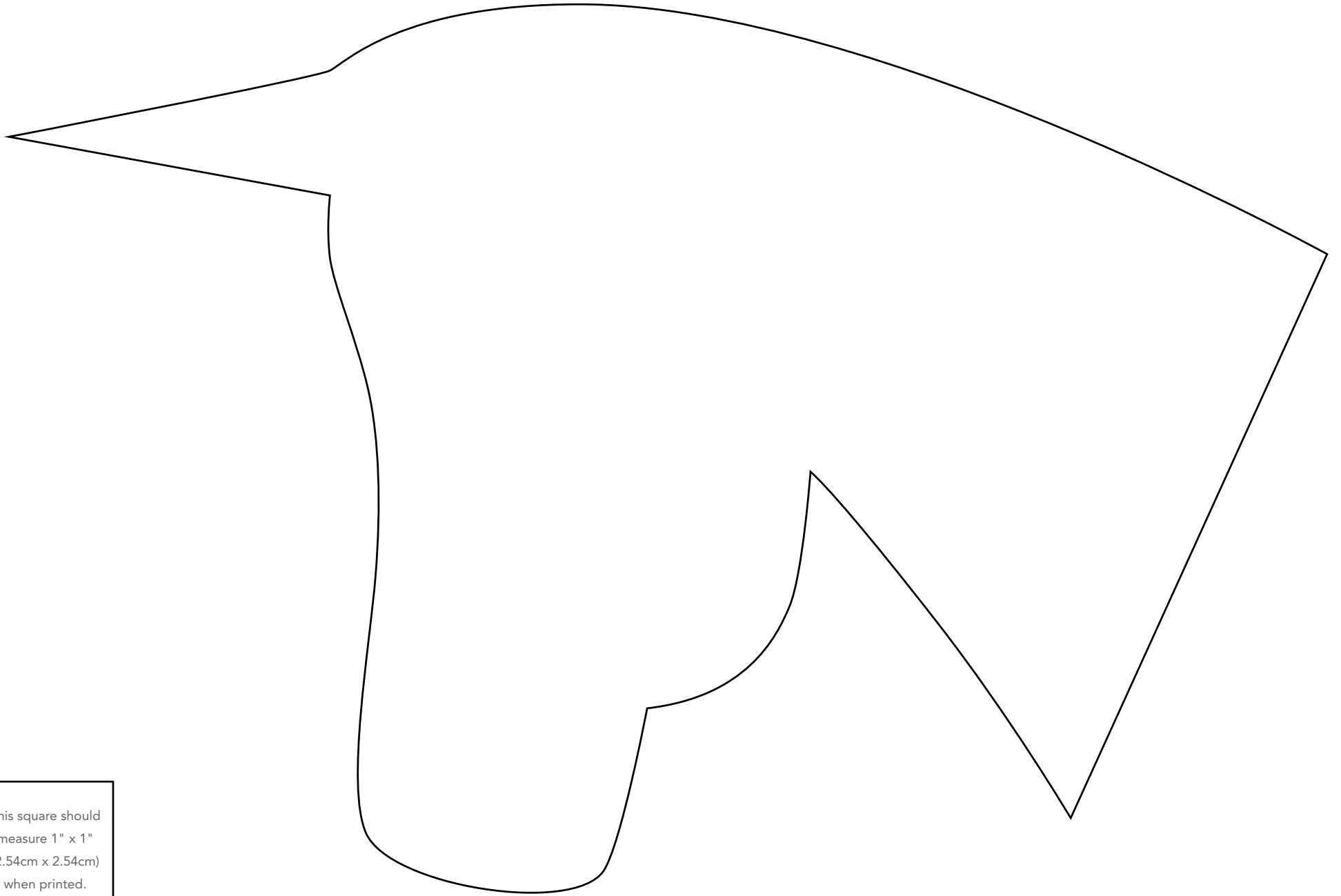
1. Cut out unicorn template and trace around it onto thick white paper stock. Make two.
2. Cut 100 strands of yarn, 3" [7.6 cm] each.
3. Cut 15 strands of yarn, 2" [5 cm] each.
4. Place plastic bag on flat surface. Using photo as reference lay longer strands of yarn onto a plastic bag and cover one end of the strands with a thick layer of craft glue. Repeat with shorter strands.
5. Allow to dry overnight.
6. After glue is dry, CAREFULLY flip the strands of yarn over and put a second thick layer of craft glue on the opposite sides. Allow to dry.
7. Positioning longer strands along the mane and shorter strands at the top of the head, glue one unicorn to each side of the yarn.
