



PENCIL CAN HOLDER | CRAFT

SHOP KIT



- Measure your can and place your adhesive on the can.
 If you are using glue you will want to add the glue only to the section you are working on.
- Cut about 24 inches of each color of yarn. Tie a knot in one end and tightly braid the three strands together. Tie a knot when finished. Repeat two more times for a total of three braids. Set aside.
- 3. With first color, start wrapping around the can for about an inch. Take one strand of the braided yarn and wrap this around twice, tie off in a knot and trim ends. Repeat two more times until you have reached the bottom of the can.
- 4. Put adhesive on the top rim of the can and with yarn; tie ends in a bow. Add yarn around bottom of the can.

FINISHING

Line the inside of the can with construction paper or some type of fabric if you wish.
